

Tie Dye Kit



SET UP:

1. Cover your work area with plastic covering, such as a plastic tablecloth or garbage bag.
2. Prewash and dry the fabric before dyeing it, this will remove anything in the fabric that prevents the dye from being absorbed.
3. Have all tools you need at the work area.

START:

1. Wear old clothes or an apron.
2. Fill the bottle with water to the marked line, replace the cap tightly, shake the bottle until the dye is completely dissolved.
3. Lay the fabric out flat on the working table, fold, twist or scrunch the fabric.
4. Use the rubber bands to hold the fabric firmly in place.
5. Wear gloves and squirt the dye onto the fabric.
6. Put your dyed fabric into a plastic zip-top bag(not included), simply leave the closed bag in a safe place, the dye will need to set for 24 hours.
7. Remove the rubber bands and check out your design.
8. Fill a bucket(not included) halfway with white vinegar, then add enough water to fill the bucket, place your dyed fabric in the bucket, let it soak for 30 minutes, so the vinegar can help your fabric retain colourfastness.
9. Wash the dyed fabric several times in a washing machine with no other clothes, then hang to dry.


NOTE:

For brighter colours, add less water into the dye powder, for lighter shades, add more water.
