Paint Your Own 3D Fairy Garden Scene



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
- 2. Cover work area with newspaper or paper towel.
- 3. Lay out all of your material in front of you.
- 4. Put on an apron or art smock before you paint.
- Keep a cup of water to clean the paint brush after applying each colour.
- 6. Close the paint lid after use.
- 7. Assemble the painted wooden pieces in order with wooden latches.

Note:

Mixing Blue and Yellow will make a close shade to Green. Mixing Red and White will make a close shade to Pink. Mixing Red, White and Yellow will make a close shade to Orange.
