# Colour Your Own Wooden Ornaments



### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
- 2. Cover work area with newspaper or paper towel.
- 3. Lay out all of your material in front of you.
- 4. Put on an apron or art smock before you paint.
- Keep a cup of water to clean the paint brush after applying each colour.
- 6. Close the paint lid after use.

### TIPS:

- 1. Add some water to the paints if they look too dry or sticky.
- Let the painted plaster dry completely after you have finished painting.
- 3. Keep the box nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.
- 4. Freely mix up colours to create new ones.

#### Note:

Mixing Pink and Blue will make a close shade to Purple. Mixing Yellow and Blue will make a close shade to Green.

### Paint Your Own Plaster Frame Kit



### **DIRECTIONS:**
