## ABC Beads Message Set

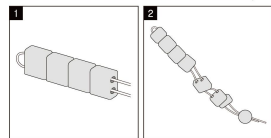
### CONTENTS:

colourful alphabet round beads (25g)  
silver round beads (30g)  
rainbow round beads (35g)  
tile beads (12g)  
shaped alphabet charms (30g)  
colourful alphabet beads (25g)  
white alphabet beads (25g)  
5 threads (40m)  
7 elastics (7m)

### TIPS:

1. After tying the threads in a loop knot, tape the knotted end on your desk to prevent the threads from sliding out. (tape not included)
2. Make sure the threads lay flat and not twisted.
3. Slide the beads through the base threads or side threads then continue knotting.
4. Make sure the tension is distributed evenly between the threads.
5. Keep the packaging nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.

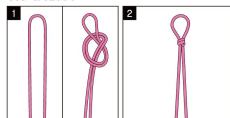
### How to make the beaded bracelets:



1. Fold elastic in half, the folded length should 5cm longer than your wrist. Thread each end of the elastic through the two holes of the tile beads. Mix and match the tile beads to create coloured-blocked designs for your trendy bracelet!
2. Spell out your style using alphabet beads! String alphabet beads through both thread of elastic to customize the bracelet with your name, monogram, or an inspiring phrase! When finished beading, you can tie both ends of thread together around your wrist.

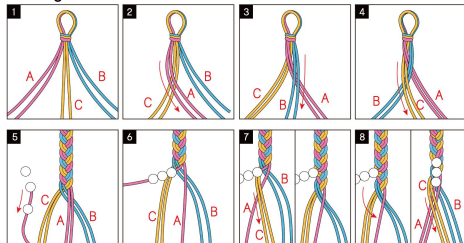
### How to braid threads:

#### Tie a knot



Fold threads in half and tie with a small loop at the head. The number of threads can be adjusted according to the knitting needs.

#### Braiding method 1:



1. Tie a knot with three threads and divide the threads into three parts by colour.
2. Cross threads A over threads C.
3. Cross threads B over threads A.
4. Repeat steps 2-3 to complete the base braid.
5. Add beads to one thread.
6. Set the thread with beads aside for now.
7. Keep braiding the other threads to match the beads length.
8. Braid all threads to a suitable length and tie a knot at the end.

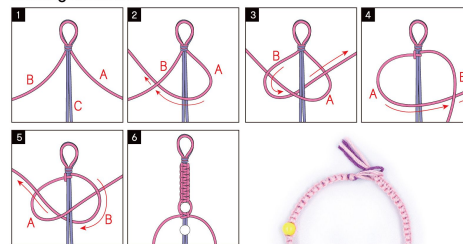


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### Braiding method 2:



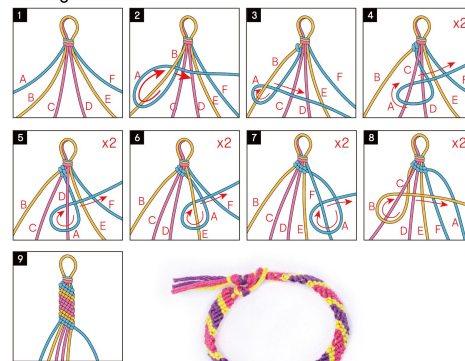
1. Tie a knot with two threads, divide one thread on either side and keep the other in the middle.
2. Cross thread A over middle threads C and under thread B.
3. Cross thread B under middle threads C and through the loop over thread A, pull tight until the knot rises to the top of bracelet.
4. Cross thread A over middle threads C and under thread B.
5. Cross thread B under middle threads C and through the loop over thread A, pull tight until the knot rises to second row of bracelet.
6. Slide the beads through middle threads C in the process of braiding. Repeat the process until the bracelet is the length that wraps loosely around your wrist and tie a knot at the end. Cut the rest off. (scissors not included)

### Braiding method 3:



1. Tie a knot with three threads, separate the threads based on colour symmetrically.
2. Tie the thread A from the top right corner of the thread B.
3. Tie the second knot on the thread B with thread A in the same way.
- 4-7. Tie the same two knots on the other threads from left to right with thread A. Then keep the thread A on the right.
8. Start a new round of knotting from left to right with thread B.
9. Repeat the process until the bracelet is the length that wraps loosely around your wrist and tie a knot at the end. Cut the rest off. (scissors not included)
