Alphabet Beading Set

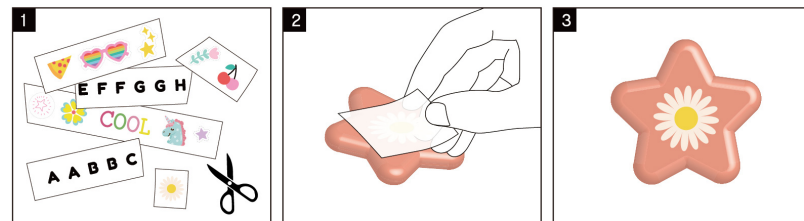

- 230 transfer stickers
- alphabet beads (52g)
- emotion beads (3g)
- colourful sparkle beads (38g)
- assorted shaped beads (4g)
- bulky beads (46g)
- 2 metallic cords (1.9m)
- 4 wax cotton cords (3.6m)
- 4 elastics (3.6m)

TIPS:

1. After tying the cords in a loop knot, tape the knotted end to your desk to prevent the cords from sliding out. (tape not included)
2. Make sure the cords lay flat and not twisted.
3. Slide the beads through the base cords or side cords then continue knotting.
4. Make sure the tension is distributed evenly between the cords.
5. Keep the packaging nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.

How to use transfer stickers



1 Cut out the shapes from the sticker sheet. (scissors not included)

2 Tear off the plastic film on the surface of the sticker, press the printed side down on the bead.

3 Gently and slowly remove the white paper, and the shapes are printed on the bead.

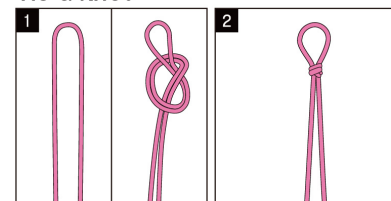

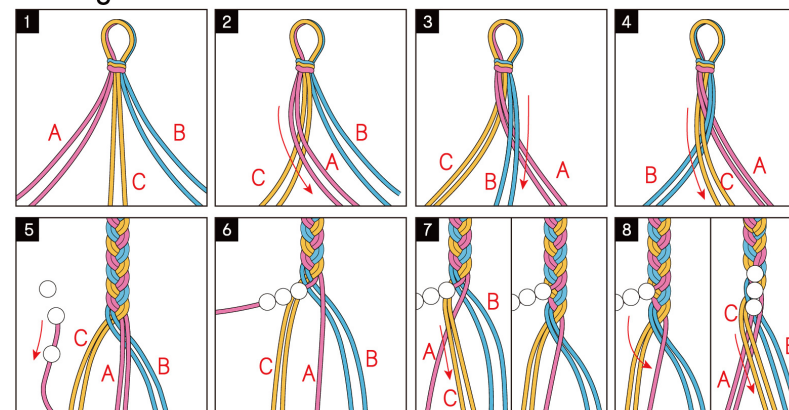
How to braid cords:

Tie a knot



Fold cords in half and tie with a small loop at the head. The number of cords can be adjusted according to the knitting needs.

Braiding method



1. Tie a knot with three cords and divide the cords into three parts by colour.
2. Cross cords A over cords C.
3. Cross cords B over cords A.
4. Repeat steps 2-3 to complete the base braid.
5. Add beads to one cord.
6. Set the cord with beads aside for now.
7. Keep braiding the other cords to match the beads length.
8. Braid all cords to a suitable length and tie a knot at the end.
