LEARN HOW TO RECYCLE

A fun way to learn about recycling categories and developing sorting and organisation skills.

AGES PLAYERS INCLUDES

3-6 years 1-5 players > 50 Picture object cards > 1 Activity spinner > 5 Recycling group boards > 5 Activity bins

GETTING READY TO PLAY THE GAME

Assemble the activity bins by folding the boxes. Adult assistance may be required.

DIFFERENT WAYS TO PLAY

- > Sort the picture cards into the correct recycling groups. Use the recycling group boards to help learn and discover the correct group for each object picture card. When familiar with each recycling group, mix the picture cards up and sort them directly into the activity bins. When all picture cards have been sorted, empty the bins and check if they have been sorted correctly using the recycling group boards. It's great to play in a group to build teamwork and encourage discussion!
- > Place the picture cards face up in front of you. Spin the activity spinner until the pointer stops at a recycle group. Test your memory and find an object picture card that belongs to that recycle group. Check if you are correct and place it into the correct recycle bin if you are!

You can play this competitively in a group by taking turns spinning the activity spinner. The player that selects the correct object picture card the quickest gets to place it into the bin. The player that sorts the most correct object picture cards wins!

> Spread the picture cards face down in front of you. Each player is given a different recycle bin. A caller will then start to flip the picture cards over one at a time. The caller will announce the picture as they show the rest of the players the card. The player who correctly identifies that the object picture card belongs in their recycle group wins the picture card and places it inside their activity bin. The caller continues to flip over and call each card one at a time. The first player to win 5 picture cards wins the game!
