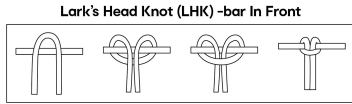


DIY Macrame Keyrings

Kit Includes

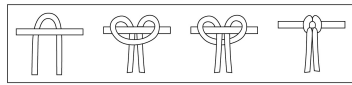
- > 4 x keyrings
- > 3 x macrame cords
- > 4 x threads
- > 2 x wooden beads
- > 1 x instruction sheet



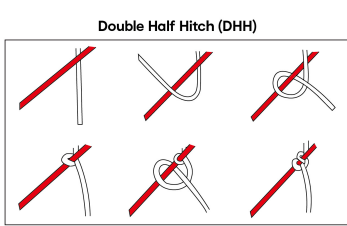
Lark's Head Knot (LHK) -bar In Front



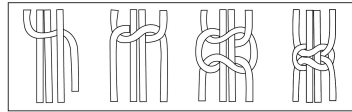
Gathering Wrap

Keyring 1

Cut The Cords

- Brown
> 110cm x 3pcs
> 30cm x 1pc

1. Fold 3pcs of 110cm cord in half and tie them onto the round ring with 3 LHK-bar in front. The right cord in the middle is the core cord.

2. Take the core cord and tie a DHH knot with cord on its left side.

3. Repeat step 2 and keep tying knots from the middle to the left.

4. Take the 3rd cord from right as the core cord and repeat steps 2-3, making DHH knots in the opposite direction.

5. Take the 4 centre cords and make a square knot as shown.

6. Take the 1st cord on the left as the core cord and repeat steps 2-3 to making a DHH knot.

7. Make a second DHH knot with the core cord and make DHH knots with all cords from right to left as shown.

8. Take the 1st cord on the right as the core cord and make DHH knots with all cords from right to left as shown.

9. Take the 3rd cord from the right as the core cord and tie a DHH knot with the second cord from the right.

10. Repeat steps 2-3 to making DHH knots from the middle to the right.

11. Repeat steps 5-8 to continue the macrame pattern down the cords.

12. Repeat steps 4-8 for the last row, making DHH knots on each cord in the from the right to middle.

13. Take the 30cm cord and make a gathering wrap around the bottom as shown. Trim the cord ends to around 6cm. To complete the keyring, brush the loose ends with a comb to create a fringed tassel.

Keyring 2

Cut The Cords

- White
> 25cm x 10pcs

1. Lay 10pcs of 25cm white cord together as shown.

2. Measure 7cm from the end. This is where you will begin wrapping.

3. Take the lilac thread and begin wrapping it tightly around all cords. Hide the thread end by wrapping over them. Continue wrapping until you reach 3.6cm length.

4. Continue wrapping the remaining thread colours as shown above.

5. Once all threads are wrapped, thread the wrapped cords through the round ring as shown. Take the teal thread and make a 7mm gathering wrap to attach it to the round ring. Trim the cord ends to around 6cm. To complete the keyring, brush the loose ends with a comb to create a fringed tassel.

Keyring 3

Cut The Cords

- White
> 60cm x 2pcs
Teal
> 150cm x 1pc

1. Fold 2pcs of 60cm cord in half and tie them onto the round ring with a LHK-bar in front.

2. Take 1pc of 150cm teal cord and place it behind the white cords as shown.

3. Tie a square knot around the white cords.

4. Using the 1st white cord on the right as the core cord, make a DHH knot with the right teal cord as shown.

5. Repeat step 4 and make another 2 DHH knots on the right side.

6. Using the 1st white cord on the left as the core cord, repeat steps 4-5, making 3 DHH knots on the left side.

7. Thread the wooden bead onto the 2 white centre cords and pull it to the top as shown.

8. Make a square knot with the teal cords to hold the wooden bead in place.

9. Repeat steps 4-6 on both sides for the second section.

10. Repeat step 7, adding the wooden bead.

11. Make 2 square knots below the wooden bead.

12. To complete the keyring, trim the cord ends to around 6cm.

Keyring 4

Cut The Cords

- White
> 70cm x 6pcs
> 50cm x 1pc

1. Fold 2 pcs of 70cm cord in half and tie them onto the round ring with LHK-bar in back as shown.

2. Take the 1st cord on the left as the core cord and make a DHH knot as shown.

3. Take the 1st cord on the right as the core cord and make a DHH knot as shown.

4. Repeat step 3 and make a second DHH knot on the right.

5. Add another 70cm cord and fold it over the left cords as shown.

6. Using the new cord as the core cord, make a DHH knot with the 1st cord on the left side.

7. Repeat step 6 and make a second DHH knot on the left side.

8. Add another 70cm cord and place it over the right cords as shown.

9. Using the new cord as the core cord, make a DHH knot with the 1st cord on the right side.

10. Repeat step 9 and make another 2 DHH knots.

11. Take another 70cm cord and fold it in half. Tie it to the first cord on the left with a LHK-bar in back as shown.

12. Take the right piece of newly attached cord and make a knot as shown.

13. Take the left piece of newly attached cord and make as shown.

14. This completes the knots with the new cord shown above.

15. Move the knots to the top of the cord.

16. Add another 70cm cord on the right side and repeat steps 11-15.

17. Take the 3rd cord from left as the core cord and make a DHH knot with the cord to its right.

18. This completes the knots shown above.

19. Repeat steps 17-18 and make another 2 DHH knots from the left to the middle.

20. Using the 3rd cord from right as the core cord, repeat steps 17-19 making a total of 4 knots in the opposite direction.

21. Using the 2nd cord from left as the core cord, repeat steps 17-19 making a total of 4 knots on the left side.

22. Using the 2nd cord from the right as the core cord, repeat steps 17-19, making a total of 5 DHH knots in the opposite direction.

23. Take the 1st cord on the left as the core cord and make a DHH knot with the next cord along.

24. This completes the 1st DHH knot of the last row shown above.

25. Take the 1st and 2nd cords on the left as the core cords and make the 2nd DHH knot of the last row.

26. This completes the 2nd DHH knot of last row shown above.

27. Repeat steps 26-27 and make DHH knots on every cord from the left to the middle as shown. This completes the left side.

28. Repeat steps 24-28 and make DHH knots in the opposite direction on the right side as shown. This completes the right side.

29. Take the 50cm cord to make gathering wrap below the heart shape. Trim the cord ends to around 6cm. To complete the keyring, brush the loose ends with a comb to create a fringed tassel.
