## RIB BEANIE WITH POM POM Easy Knit

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### MEASUREMENTS

- › To fit head (approx) 56 cm

### MATERIALS

- › Super Chunky 100g x 2 balls

### NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- › 1 pair 12mm knitting needles, or size that gives correct tension.
- › A yarn needle
- › Strong sewing thread for sewing seam (to prevent a bulky seam)
- › Large pom pom maker

### TENSION

- › 6 sts and 9 rows to 10 cm over stocking st, using 12mm needles.

### BEANIE

- › Using 12mm needles, cast on 31 sts.
- › **Beg rib** – 1st row (RS) – K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.
- › 2nd row – P1, \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.
- › Rep 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 16 cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.
- › **Shape Crown** – 1st row – K1, \* sl 1, K2tog, pssso, rib 3, rep from \* to end = 21 sts.
- › Work 3 rows rib.
- › 5th row – K1, \* sl 1, K2tog, pssso, rib 1, rep from \* to end = 11 sts.
- › Work 1 row rib.
- › Break off yarn leaving a long end. Run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

### FINISHING

- › DO NOT PRESS.
- › Darn in ends.
- › Using strong sewing thread and a **flat seam**, join side edges together to form centre back seam.
- › Make a large pom pom and sew to top of beanie as pictured.
