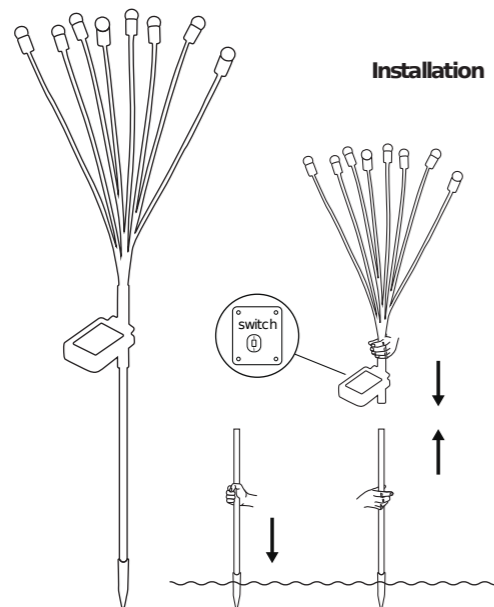

Product Introduction

Solar lights enhance any garden by harnessing solar energy during the day to charge their batteries. With the switch on, they use stored energy to automatically turn off during the day and on at night. The duration of illumination depends on their placement, weather conditions, and seasonal lighting availability.

Product Specifications

1. Choose a location with ample sunlight to ensure the solar panel receives maximum sunlight.
2. Insert the ground spike portion of the light into the soil first, making sure it is secure before inserting the socket at the bottom of the lamp base onto the spike.
3. Ensure the switch is in the ON position and allow the light to charge in the sun for 6-8 hours before first use.

Operating Instructions

- Switch Operation: There is a switch at the bottom of the solar panel; make sure it is turned on before use.
- Automatic Switching: With the switch on, a built-in sensor ensures the light turns on at dusk and off at dawn automatically.

Safety Information

- Operate and install the solar lights as per the instructions.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the lights. Install them away from shade and large obstructions to ensure efficient charging. Consult a professional when installing at height to avoid fall hazards.
- Keep the solar panel clean and free of debris. Avoid exposing the lights to fire, extreme heat, or water.
- Keep away from children and pets. Do not operate the lights within their packaging. String lights may pose a strangulation hazard; ensure they are properly secured and out of reach of children.
- Not suitable for use by individuals with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities without supervision or instruction from a responsible adult.

Maintenance and Care

Regularly wipe the solar panel with a clean cloth to prevent dust accumulation affecting efficiency.

Troubleshooting

Solar Lights Not Illuminating
 Charge: Ensure the solar panel has received at least 6 hours of direct sunlight with the switch on during the day.
 Switch: Verify that the lights are turned on at night.
 Battery: Check that the battery contacts are securely connected to the terminals.
 Solar Panel Maintenance: Keep the panel clean and free from obstruction.
 Location: Avoid placement near strong artificial lights or in the shade of buildings or trees.
