

# DIY Macrame Jute Coasters Kit Instruction Manual

## Kit Includes

- > 1 x jute rope, 40m
- > 1 x instruction sheet

## Tips:

- > Tie knots firmly, yet gently enough that the rope maintains its shape. Pull evenly with both rope ends. Nest knots snugly without crowding.
- > For a uniform look, tie knots in a consistent manner.

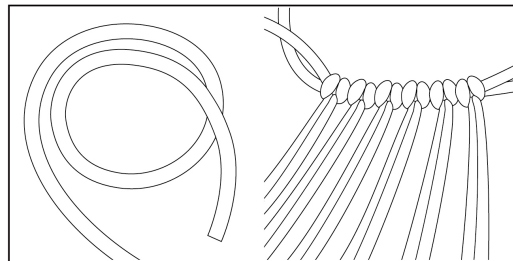
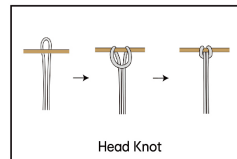
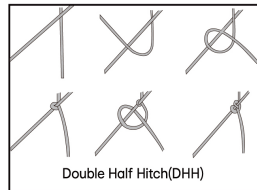
## How To Make A Jute Coaster

Precut the rope as follows:

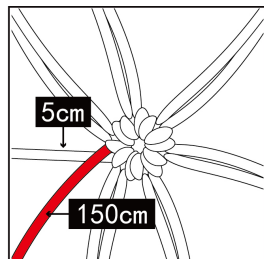
- 1 x 150cm, main strand
- 8 x 80cm (6 to start, 2 additional to fill gaps)

Additional rope to fill gaps:

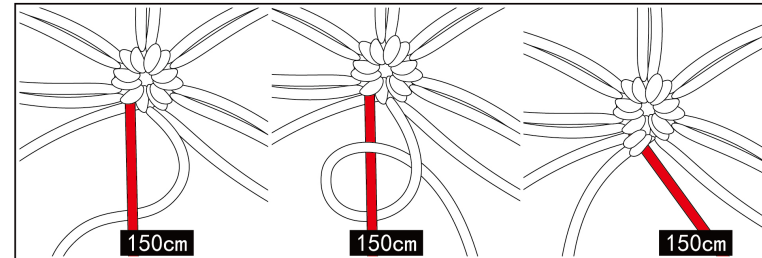
- 1 x 70cm for 3rd round
- 1 x 60cm for 4th round
- 1 x 50cm for 5th round
- 2 x 40cm for 6th & 7th round



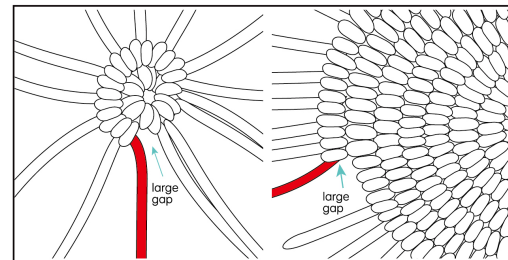
- Take the main strand (150cm) and make a loop shape as shown. Take 6 80cm strands and thread them through the loop. Attach all 6 onto the double rope section of the loop using a head knot, as shown.



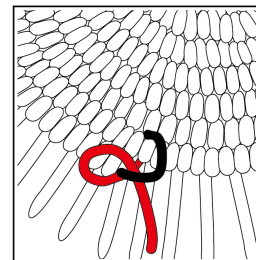
- Once all 6 of the 80cm strands are attached, pull the main 150cm strand to tighten. Make sure that the short section of the main strand is about 5cm long, this should be placed at the back of the coaster. The long strand should be on the left as shown.



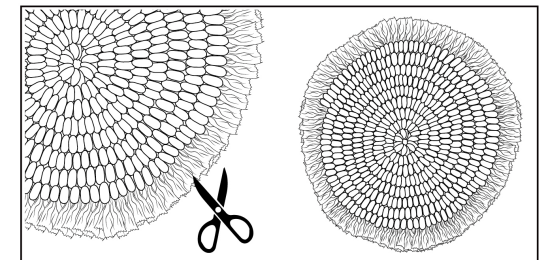
- Start to knot using a double half hitch for the first round. Make sure that the main strand (150cm strand) is above the first strand of closest head knot on the right, start to make DHH knots for each strand.



- After the first row, add an additional strand (80cm strand) to the main strand where there is a gap or large space. Add it by making a head knot on the main strand, then continue making DHH knots on all strands. Each round requires an additional rope to fill a gap. Repeat step 4 to add the additional strands. Use the pre cut rope lengths specified for each round.



- Complete 6 - 7 rounds, then tie or sew the main strand into the coaster to finish it off and trim.



- Trim the ropes and use a comb to brush through the edges, separating the strands into a fringe. Cut fringe to desired length to complete a coaster.
