
Tips

- > Use the stencils provided or find your own flowers and leaves to create your desired patterns.
- > For best results, prepare the print in dim light before exposing it to sun light.
- > If there is little sunlight, expose the print for longer.
- > Lay the print on paper towel to dry it.




How To Make A Sun Print Greeting Card




Select a stencil sheet. In the order shown, layer the PET sheet, stencil sheet, and sun print sheet on top of a piece of cardboard or book (not included). Ensure the sun print sheet is blue side up.



Place the layered sheets in direct sunlight for 1–5 minutes. The areas of the paper exposed to the sun will fade from blue to white, leaving a pattern.



Remove the sun print sheet and rinse it in water. The colours will reverse, with white becoming blue and blue becoming white. Leave the sheet in water for 1-5 minutes to achieve a deep blue colour.



Lay your sun print paper flat on an absorbent surface and allow it to dry. To complete a greeting card, glue the sun print paper onto the greeting card front and allow it to dry for a few minutes.
