Plant Hanger Kit Instruction Manual

Lark's Head Knot (LHK) -bar In Front

Kit Includes

- > 2 x macrame cord colours
- > 2 x metal rings
- > 1 x instruction sheet

1100 to 2000 to

- Tie knots firmly, yet gently enough that the cord maintains its shape. Pull evenly with both cord ends. Nest knots snugly without crowding.
- > For a uniform look, tie knots in a consistent manner.
- Macrame basket fits 6.5cm pots

Cut The Cords

- > 200cm x 8pcs > 50cm x 2pcs



Take 8pcs 200cm cords and thread them through the metal ring. There will be 16 single cords hanging from the metal ring.












Square Knot (SK)




Half Knot (HK)













Take 1pc 50cm cord and make a gathering wrap under the metal ring. Trim off the excess cord used for your gathering wrap.




Divide the 16 cords into 4 groups of 4 cords. Each group should consist of 2 short cords placed in the centre, and 2 long cords, 1pc either side as shown. Measure 3cm below the gathering wrap and begin making half knots on one of the groups of cords. Continue to make half knots, creating a spiral pattern 9.5cm in length (total 5 half knots).

Join the 4 hanging groups together by taking 4 cords shown from 2 groups, (2 from each) as shown. Measure 5cm below the half knots and tie a square knot.



Repeat step 4 and make another 3 square knots, joining all of the groups to complete the row.



Measure 6.5cm below the row of square knots. Take 1pc 50cm rope to make a 4cm gathering wrap. Then, trim the cord ends to make a 9cm hanging tassel.



To complete the planter, add your own pot (approx. 6.5cm diamater) and plant, then hang it in your desired location.
