Slin knot

Every piece of crochet chain starts with a slip knot, Loop the yarn around two fingers (leaving a tail) and pull the tail halfway through the loop. Insert the crochet hook into the second loop and gently pull the loop taut onto the crochet





2. Chain Stitch (Abbroviated 'ch')

The chain stitch is the basis for all crochet which is also called a foundation chain



3. Slip Stitch (Abbroviated 'sl st')

The slip stitch is the flattest or smallest of all crochet stitches. You can use this stitch by slip-stitching the ends of a foundation chain to form a ring.









4. Single Crochet (Abbreviated 'sc')

The single crochet is the most fundamental of all stitches. Gather the uarn with your crochet hook and draw up the loop through the stitch. Wrap the uarn ground the hook and pull it through two loops. leaving one loop on the hook.



Increase (Abbreviated 'inc')

You can increase stitches by adding a stitch at the beginning of the row. Make 2 sc in the same knot



6. Decrease (Abbreviated 'dec')

You can decrease stitches, which is really just subtracting a stitch, in a row. Make a half sc. at which point there are 2 loops in the hook, then crochet a half sc in the next knot, at which point there are 3 loops in the hook, and finally wind the yarn through all 3 loops to finish a dec.





7. Double Crochet (Abbreviated 'Dc')

The double crochet is one of the most common crochet stitches and is about twice as tall as a single crochet. Wrap the uarn ground the crochet hook. Then insert the crochet hook into the next stitch loop. Wrap the uarn with uour crochet hook and pull the loop through the stitch (three loops now on the hook).Wrap the yarn around the hook again and pull it through the first two loops, leaving two loops on the hook. Then, wrap the yarn around the hook again and bring it through the remaining two loops to leave only one loop on the book Complete the row







8. Round (Abbreviated 'Rd')

This continues the chain stitches into a circle. Each round starts with ch and ends with sl st.

9. Fasten off (Abbreviated 'F/O')

Fasten off by pulling the yarn through the end stitch and pulling it taut. Cut off.





10.Half double crochet (Abbreviated 'hdc') Wrap the yarn around the hook then insert the hook into the

next stitch. Wrap the uarn around the hook and pull through al loops.

The triple crochet is also called a treble crochet, creates



longer openings between the stitches









Generally used for the connection of 2 parts. The plastic needle strap uarns are threaded in turn through the knots where the two parts need to be connected





13. Insert your hook into 2nd back hoop



If details need to be stitched onto the finished product (such as mouth, eyes, etc.), you can use a plastic needle strap uarns up and down the finished product along the hooked









15. Magic ring

When crocheting round shape, make 1 magic ring first and then crochet from the center. Crochet through the circle loop in the hand to pull back the taut yarn, make 1 sc to form the first knot. After some sc. pull the bottom ugrn tight until all knots form a ring. Make 1 ch in the first knot to alse the magic ring.







16. Weaving in/invisible close

Cut the yarn, leaving a long yarn end. Draw the end through the final loop on the hook and thread it onto a yarn needle. Weave your needle through the front loops only on the last round and pull tight. Weave remaining ugrn into your piece

R5: 24 sc [24 sts], F/O Now you have finished 1 green

sunflower heart. Please follow the above step to make 1 brown sunflower heart.

2. Petal

Take both the brown and green flower hearts and line up the edges, you will be crocheting through both hearts to create the petals.

1. In the first stitch: 2ch, dc, tr, 2ch, insert your hook into 2nd back hoop and crochet sl. 2. In the second stitch: tr, dc, 2ch.

3. In the third stitch: sl.

Once you have made 7 petals, fill the middle with fiberfill and then complete the remaining 5 petals to close.

3. Leaf

1. (Please use the green uarn) 16ch. insert your hook into 2nd back hoop and

starts crochet. 2. (sc, hdc, 3dc, sc, sl, sc, hdc, 3dc, hdc, sc) x 2 times.

4. Sunflower Stem

1. (Please use the green yarn) Make 65 double chains to finish the flower rachis.

2. Sew it on the back of the heart with plastic needle.


