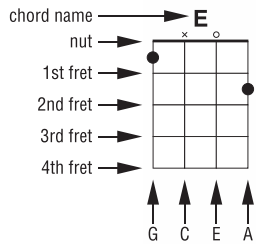


21" UKULELE

CHORDS

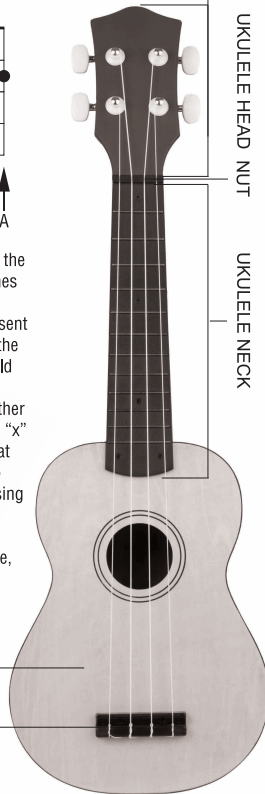
Ukulele chords can be conveniently represented in a diagram like this:



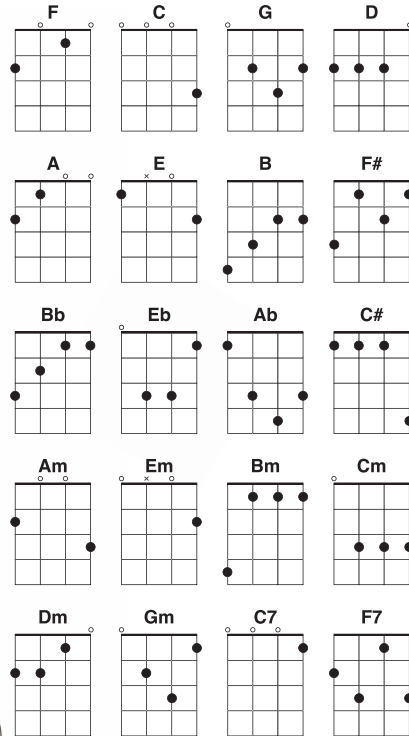
The large letter above the diagram is the name of the chord. The horizontal lines represent the nut and frets on the ukulele neck. The vertical lines represent the 4 ukulele strings. The circles on the strings show where the strings should be pressed down for that chord. If a string does not have a circle on it, either an "x" or "o" will appear above it. An "x" means that you should not sound that string in this chord. An "o" means to sound the string open, without pressing down on it. Try playing the different chords. Though some may seem difficult at first, the more you practice, the more natural you will feel!
