Every piece of crochet chain starts with a slip knot. Loop the yarn around two fingers (leaving a tail) and pull the tail halfway through the loop. Insert the crochet hook into the second loop and gently pull the loop taut onto the crochet

4. Single Crochet (Abbreviated 'Sc')
The single crochet is the most fundamental of all stitches.
Gather the yorr with your crochet hook and draw up the loop through the stitch. Wrap the yarr around the hook and pull it through two loops, leaving one loop on the hook.





You can increase stitches by adding a stitch at the beginning of the row. Make 2 sc in the same knot.







## 6. Decrease (Abbreviated 'dec')

You can decrease stitches, which is really just subtracting a
stitch, in a row. Make a half so, at which point there are 2
loops in the hook, then crochet a half so in the next knot, at

8. Sewing
Generally used for the connection of 2 parts. The plastic Cenerally used for the connection of 2 parts. The plassic-needle strap yarns are threaded in turn through the knots where the two parts need to be connected.

If details need to be stitched onto the finished product (such as mouth, eyes, etc.), you can use a plastic needle strap yarns up and down the finished product along the hooked grain.

11. Weaving in/invisible close

Cut the yam, leaving a long yam end. Draw the end through the final loop on the hook and thread it anto a yam needle. Weave your needle through the front loops only on the last round and pull tight. Weave remaining yam into your piece.
