Christmas Tree Embroidery Kit

KIT INCLUDES:

15CM BAMBOO HOOP

PRINTED MATERIAL

5 X FMBROIDERY THREADS

3 A LIVIDIOIDLINI ITINLAD

MIXED SEQUINS

GOLD BEADS

NEEDLES

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- DO NOT PRE-WASH FABRIC
- FOLD LINES IN FABRIC SHOULD STRETCH OUT ONCE HOOP IS APPLIED. IF NOT, YOU CAN CHOOSE TO IRON ON A LOW HEAT SEATING BEFORE BEGINNING.
- CUT EMBROIDERY THREAD INTO 1 METRE LENGTHS, AS THIS IS A MORE MANAGEABLE LENGTH TO WORK WITH.
- TIE A KNOT TO START AND END YOUR THREAD.
- BEGINNERS MAY WANT TO PRACTICE STITCH TYPES BEFORE BEGINNING THE PROJECT


OTHER SUPPLIES REQUIRED:

SCISSORS

HOT OR LOW TEMPERATURE GLUE GUN

INSTRUCTIONS:


- LOOSEN THE SCREW ON THE HOOP AND SEPARATE THE TWO HOOP PIECES.
- 2. CENTRE THE FABRIC OVER THE INNER
- 3. PRESS THE OUTER RING ON TOP AND START TO TIGHTEN THE SCREW. BEFORE YOU TWIST THE SCREW ALL THE WAY GENTLY PULL THE SIDES OF THE FABRIC UNTIL IT IS NICE AND TAUT. THEN TIGHTEN THE SCREW FULLY TO HOLD THE FABRIC IN PLACE.
- 4. USE EACH COLOUR OF EMBROIDERY THREAD TO STITCH THE DESIGN AS PER THE GUIDE IMAGE.
- 5. SEW ON SEQUINS AND BEADS TO DECORATE.
- 6. ONCE YOU HAVE COMPLETED YOUR STITCHING, TURN THE HOOP OVER AND USING SCISSORS, TRIM AWAY THE EXTRA FABRIC ON THE BACK. AN ALTERNATIVE IS TO ADD A LITTLE HOT GLUE ALONG THE EDGE OF THE INSIDE OF THE HOOP AND FOLD YOUR FABRIC OVER TO STICK EXCESS IN PLACE.

LEARNING THE STITCHES

OVERHAND KNOT

USE AN OVERHAND KNOT TO TIE OFF THE EMBROIDERY THREAD BEFORE BEGINNING, AND AT THE END OF THE AREA YOU ARE STITCHING.



Pass the end of the thread around and over itself to form a loop.



Tuck it inside the loop and pull it out completely.



Pull both ends to tighten

STRAIGHT STITCH



point A and then back down at point B to create a single straight stitch.



If you have another stitch to complete near by, bring the needle back up at point C and back down at point D.

SPLIT STITCH



To begin, bring the needle up from the back of the fabric at the left end of the line to be worked. Take it down through the fabric to the right, making a single stitch.



Bring the needle up through the first stitch, splitting the fibres.



Take the needle down again, completing the stitch.



Continue to the end of the line.



ADDING SEQUINS AND BEADS

Bring the needle up from point A. Push the needle through a sequin and thread on a bead. Take the needle back down at point B and tie an overhand knot at the back. of the fabric



To add a single bead, bring the needle up from point A. Thread on a bead. Take the needle back down at point B and tie an overhand knot at the back of the fabric.
