BATTERY INSTALLATION

(E) Use 2 x 1.5v type AAA batteries. Take care to fit batteries observing the plus & minus markings. Replace all used batteries at the same time. Do not mix used and new batteries, rechargeable, different types (alkaline or carbon zinc), or different brands of batteries. Only use batteries of the same type. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision. The supply terminals are not to be recharded batteries are to be removed immediately. To insert / replace batteries: Unscrew battery cover and insert batteries, observing polarity guide. Ensure battery cover is securely screwed in place before use. The crossed out wheelie-bin symbol on this product is to remind you that waste electrical and electronic products, batteries and accumulators should not be disposed of with household waste.
