## **IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS**

Important instructions. Retain for future use.

Before using this appliance, read and follow all warnings and instructions in this manual, even if you are familiar with this product.

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- 2. **DO NOT** use this product as a substitute for medical attention.
- 3. **DO NOT** use this product for more than 45 minutes at a time.
- 4. The unattended use of heat by children or incapacitated persons may be dangerous.
- 5. (2) 0-3
- This product is not to be used by very young children (0-3 years). Children under the age of three are not to use this appliance due to their inability to react to overheating.
- 6. This appliance must not be used by persons insensitive to heat and other very vulnerable persons who are unable to react to overheating.
- 7. This product is not intended for medical use. It is intended to provide warmth to relieve discomfort. If you have any concerns regarding your health, consult your doctor before using this appliance.
- 8. Individuals with pacemakers should consult a physician before using this product.
- 9. In case of pregnancy, diabetes or illness, consult your doctor before using this product.
- 10. Never use on the face, open wounds, discoloured areas, areas of poor circulation or any areas of the body that are swollen, burned, inflamed or where skin eruptions or sores are present.
- 11. DO NOT use the appliance while under the influence of alcohol, sleeping pills or sedatives.
- 12. **DO NOT** store or use the appliance near or in high temperature areas.
- 13. It is normal to feel itching, tingling or see redness on area of the skin where the appliance covers after use. These symptoms will soon disappear. However, if these symptoms remain for an extended period, we suggest you consult your doctor as there may be a more serious underlying issue.
- 14. DO NOT leave the appliance unattended when in use or plugged in.
- 15. Take care that children cannot touch the appliance when in use, and make sure they cannot reach and pull the power cord.
- 16. To protect against the risk of electric shock, do not immerse the appliance or the USB cord in water or other liquids.
- 17. **DO NOT** use or store the product near sinks, baths or showers containing water or near running water.
- 18. Always disconnect the appliance from the power supply after use.
- 19. The use of accessories not intended for use with this appliance may cause injuries to the user or damage to the appliance.
- 20. If this appliance is to be used by a third party, please supply the instruction manual with it.
- 21. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- 22. **DO NOT** operate the appliance with wet hands or wet feet to reduce the risk of electric shock.
- 23. **DO NOT** use the appliance while sleeping, feeling sleepy or in bed.

- 24. **DO NOT** use machinery or heavy equipment while using this appliance.
- 25. **DO NOT** cover the appliance while in use. The product will overheat and may cause fire, electrocution, damage to property or injury to persons.
- 26. Prolonged Heat application can result in skin burns.
- 27. This appliance is intended for human use only. Not for animals and pets.
- 28. ONLY for indoor domestic use.
- 29. Turn to green light setting for any continuous use.
- 30. When the appliance is likely to be used for an extended period, for instance by the user falling asleep, controls should be adjusted to green light setting.
- 31. This appliance is not intended for medical use in hospitals.
- 32. Only use the USB Cable that was supplied with this appliance.



The power must only be supplied at safety extra low voltage corresponding to the rating specified on the appliance's Rating label.

- 33. Do Not wash the appliance in water or any other liquid. Clean the appliance in accordance with the instructions provided under the "CLEANING AND STORAGE" section.
- 34. Always follow the washing instruction attached to the heating wrap.



## KNOW YOUR WRIST HEATING WRAP



#### **USE YOUR WRIST HEATING WRAP**

#### NOTE:

- The appliance will automatically turn off after approximately 45 minutes.
- Do Not use more than 2 times a day. (Total of 90 minutes per day at any temperature setting)
   Always remember to turn off and unplug the appliance when not in use.
- Fully unravel the USB cable. Plug the small end of the USB cable into the power inlet of the appliance.
- Put the hanging loop on your thumb, use the touch fastener to fix the appliance around your wrist.
- 3. Insert the large USB plug into a USB power supply (not included) that providing 5Vd.c. with an output of 2A, the button flashes red blue and green in turn then goes out.
- 4. Press and hold the button until it light up in red, now the appliance start heating. Press the button for other temperature setting. The temperature setting as follows:

Button light color	Approx. heating temperature
Green	45℃
Blue	50°C
Red	55℃

- 5. Press and hold the button another time to stop heating.
- 6. After using the appliance, disconnect the USB cable with the appliance and power supply. Warning! Examine the appliance before use to ensure no signs of wear damage. If there are such signs, or the appliance doesn't work, DO NOT use it anymore.

## **CLEANING AND STORAGE**

- After using the appliance, disconnect the USB cable with the appliance and power supply.
- Do Not wash the appliance in water or any other liquid. Please always follow the washing
  instructions attached to the heat wrap.
- Clean the appliance only with a soft, very slight damp cloth.
- NEVER allow water or any other liquids to come into contact with the appliance especially
  the power socket or power supply.
- NEVER use abrasive cleaners, solvents, steel wool, scouring pads, brushes, or strong chemicals that might or might not be flammable and/or damaging to the product to clean.
- When storing the appliance, allow it to cool down before folding.
- Do not crease the appliance by placing items on top of it during storage.
- Do Not wind the power supply cord around the appliance body as this will damage the cord
  over time. Simply loop the cable and place next to the appliance.
- Store your appliance in a cool, dry location.
