# BASIC CROCHET STITCH DIAGRAM 1. Stitch (Abbroviated 'st')

Every piece of crochet chain starts with a slip knot. Loop the yarn around two fingers (leaving a tail) and pull the tail halfway through the loop. Insert the crochet hook into the second loop and gently pull the loop taut onto the crochet









# Chain Stitch (Abbroviated 'ch')

The chain stitch is the basis for all crachet which is also called a foundation chain









## Slip Stitch (Abbroviated 'sl st') The slip stitch is the flattest or smallest of all crochet

stitches. You can use this stitch by slip-stitching the ends of a foundation chain to form a ring.







## 4. Single Crochet (Abbreviated 'sc')

The single crochet is the most fundamental of all stitches. Gather the yarn with your crochet hook and draw up the loop through the stitch. Wrap the uarn ground the hook and pull it through two loops, leaving one loop on the hook,







# Increase (Abbreviated 'inc')

You can increase stitches by adding a stitch at the beginning of the row. For exemple, make 2 sc in the same knot.









# 6. Decrease (Abbreviated 'dec')

You can decrease stitches, which is really just subtracting a stitch, in a row. Make a half so, at which point there are 2 loops in the hook, then crochet a half so in the next knot, at which point there are 3 loops in the hook, and finally wind the uarn through all 3 loops to finish a dec.









## 7. Double Crochet (Abbreviated 'Dc')

The double crochet is one of the most common crochet stitches and is about twice as tall as a single crochet. Wrap the uarn around the crochet hook. Then insert the crochet hook into the next stitch loop. Wrap the yarn with your crochet hook and pull the loop through the stitch (three loops now on the hook). Wrap the yarn ground the hook again and pull it through the first two loops, leaving two loops on the hook. Then, wrap the yarn around the hook again and bring it through the remaining two loops to leave only one loop on the hook. Complete the row



# 8. Half Double Crochet (Abbreviated 'hdc')

Wrap the yarn around the hook then insert the hook into the next stitch.Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull through



2. Comb







# 9. Round (Abbreviated 'Rd')

This continues the chain stitches into a circle. Each round starts with ch and ends with slist.

5 ch, insert your hook into 2nd back hoop to make 1 sc,

Repeat 2 times, and sew them together. (Fig. 3-4)

## 10. Fasten Off (Abbreviated 'F/O')

Fasten off by pulling the yarn through the end stitch and pulling it taut. Cut off.



## 11. Triple Crochet (Abbreviated 'tr')

The triple grochet is also called a treble grochet, greates longer openings between the stitches

## 13. Magic Ring

A magic ring is an adjustable starting round used for crochet amigurumi patterns, grannu squares and other patterns that work in crochet rounds. Form a loop with your yarn. You will need to loop the upm ground upur fingers, insert the hook through the loop. Slide the crochet hook under right piece of uarn from right to left, use the hook tip to grab onto a left uarn. pull the yarn through the ring, make a chain stitch. Put your first row of stitches into the ring. For example, make 6 sc. Pull yarn ends. Hold the working end of the yarn tout while gently pulling down on the tail end. As you do this, the stitches should close together at the center, completing your magic ring. Finally, slip stitch into the first stitch. To close this round and start the remainder of your pattern, make a slip stitch into the first stitch of your ring, and proceed to the next round.



# 14. Sewing

anko

Generally used for the connection of 2 parts. The plastic needle strap yarns are threaded in turn through the knots where the two parts need to be connected.



If details need to be stitched anto the finished product ( such as mouth, eyes, etc). Use the plastic needle and thread to create small stitches to represent facial features etc.







## 15. Weaving In/Invisible Close

Cut the yarn, leaving a long yarn end. Draw the end through the final loop on the hook and thread it anto a yarn needle. Weave your needle through the front loops only on the last round and pull tight. Weave remaining yarn into your piece.

R5: (3 sc. inc) x 6 times [30 sts]

R6: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) x 5 times, 2 sc [36 sts] R7: 36 sc [36 sts]

R8: (5 sc, inc) x 6 times [42 sts] R9: 42 so [42 sts]

R10: 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc) x 5 times, 3 sc [48 sts] R11: 48 sc [48 sts]

R12: (7 sc, inc) x 6 times [54 sts] R13-22: 54 so [54 sts]

R23: (7 sc. dec) x 6 times [48 sts] R24: (6 sc, dec) x 6 times [42 sts]

R25: (5 sc, dec) x 6 times [36 sts] R26: (4 sc, dec) x 6 times [30 sts]

R27: (3 sc, dec) x 6 times [24 sts] R28: (2 sc, dec) x 6 times [18 sts] Fill with the fiberfill.

R29: (sc. dec) x 6 times [12 sts] R30: 6 dec [6 sts] F/O


















# 3. Mouth

(Please use the orange yarns) 4 ch, insert your hook into 2nd back hoop to make 1 sc. (hdc. dc) (do, hdc), sl. (hdc, dc), (dc, hdc, sc).

(Please use the orange yams)

1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 tr in turn, F/O. (Fig. 1-2)



R1: 6 sc in magic ring [6 sts] R2: (sc, inc) x 3 times [9 sts] R3: (2 sc, inc) x 3 times [12 sts] R4: (3 sc, inc) x 3 times [15 sts] R5-8: 15 sc [15 sts]

Fill with the fiberfill. R9: (sc, dec) x 8 times [7 sts] R10: 5 dec [2 sts] F/O

## 5. Eggshell

(Please use the white yarns) R1: 8 sc in magic ring [8 sts] R3: (sc, inc) x 8 times [24 sts] R5: (3 sc, inc) x 8 times [40 sts]

R4: (2 sc. inc) x 8 times [32 sts] R6: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) x 7 times, 2 sc [48 sts] R7: (5 sc, inc) x 8 times [56 sts] R8-11: 56 sc [56 sts]

R2: 8 inc [16 sts]

# R12: [(sc. hdc. dc. 1 ch. dc. hdc. sc. st), (sc. hdc. dc. tr. 1 ch. tr. dc, hdc, sc, sl)] x 3 times, (sc, hdc, dc, 1 ch, dc, hdc, sc, sl), sc,









### 6. Sewing all the parts

1. Use the plastic needle to sew the eggshell onto the body then the comb, mouth and wings. (Fig. 1-4) Once finished, hide the excess threads inside the bodu.

2. Please use the black yarns to sew an "X" on both sides of R9 of the body as the chick's eyes. (Fig. 6-7)
