BASIC CROCHET STITCH DIAGRAM 1. Stitch (Abbroviated 'st')

Every piece of crochet chain starts with a slip knot. Loop the yarn around two fingers (leaving a tail) and pull the tail halfway through the loop. Insert the crochet hook into the second loop and gently pull the loop taut onto the crochet







2. Chain Stitch (Abbroviated 'ch')

The chain stitch is the basis for all crochet which is also called a foundation chair







3. Slip Stitch (Abbroviated 'sl st')

The slip stitch is the flattest or smallest of all crochet stitches. You can use this stitch by slip-stitching the ends of a foundation chain to form a ring.







4. Single Crochet (Abbreviated 'sc')

The single crochet is the most fundamental of all stitches. Gather the uarn with your crochet hook and draw up the loop through the stitch. Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull it through two loops, leaving one loop on the hook.



5. Increase (Abbreviated 'inc')

You can increase stitches by adding a stitch at the beginning of the row. For exemple make 2 sc in the same knot.



6. Decrease (Abbreviated 'dec')

You can decrease stitches, which is really just subtracting a stitch, in a row. Make a half sc, at which point there are 2 loops in the hook, then crochet a half so in the next knot, at which point there are 3 loops in the hook, and finally wind the uarn through all 3 loops to finish a dec.




