



The SD memory card must be inserted before power on if you want to record or photo taking. Please insert the video recorder with SD card inserted in if device doesn't detect the SD card.

Battery installation

• Slide down to open and remove the battery cover, and install three AAA alkaline batteries according to the polarity signs on terminals location. The close it by sliding the leading end of battery cover into battery latch, press down the cover to latch the battery compartment securely.

Note: Reverse installation direction of anode (positive) and cathode (Negative) may lead to damage onto the video recorder or a fire accident.




