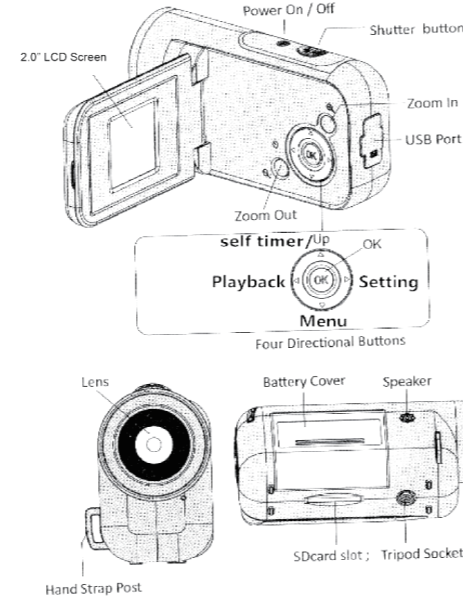

Insert SD memory Card

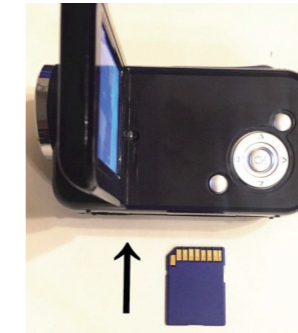
Please insert SD memory card as below diagram, and make sure that the golden finger is facing downwards (Beware of the orientation of video recorder)

Note:

1pc 4GB TF card+ SD adaptor included.
 Max support 16GB (need to purchase separately)

The SD memory card must be inserted before power on if you want to record or photo taking. Please insert the video recorder with SD card inserted in if device doesn't detect the SD card.

Diagram for inserting SD memory card



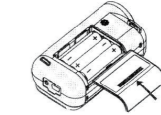
Battery installation

• Slide down to open and remove the battery cover, and install three AAA alkaline batteries according to the polarity signs on terminals location.
 • The close it by sliding the leading end of battery cover into battery latch, press down the cover to latch the battery compartment securely.

Note: Reverse installation direction of anode (positive) and cathode (Negative) may lead to damage onto the video recorder or a fire accident.

Attention: This product is not waterproof. Please be careful during use.

Video Mode

This section is about how to record with this video recorder.

Go to video Mode

	Power button: Hold it for 2-3 seconds to turn the recorder on.
	Press to select video mode (Changing mode from camera to video. Default mode is Camera.)
	Press to start recording video and press again to save video
	Press to find video album and press OK button to play video

- If the memory card capacity is low, it can't support to take videos.

- Press "▶" to enter into playback menu to lock/unlock/delete the file as below sheet.

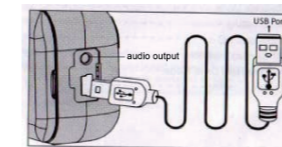
