1. Preparation time!

2. Mix it up!

- › Shake your paint bottles before use.
- › Grab your mixing cup and gently pour the paint colours in one at a time.
- › The more layers of paint you add to the cup the greater the marble effect when pouring.



3. Pour the mix!



Hold your character by the ear, and slowly pour the paint mix over the body from top to bottom. Turn it over and repeat for the back.



Stand your character up and pour the remaining paint over the ears and allow the paint to run down it's body.

4. Dry & display!

- › Wash your hands with warm soapy water after use.
- › Allow approximately 24 hours for the body to be dry to the touch.
- › Peel off the clean sheet.
- › After you confirm that the paint on the body of the bunny is dry, lay your character down to allow excess paint on the feet to dry.
- › Allow roughly 1-2 days to fully dry (drying times may vary).
- › Display your work of art on a bookshelf or desk.

2. Mix it up!
