## RIB BEANIE

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### Easy Knit

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#### MEASUREMENTS

- › To fit head (approx) 56 – 58cm

#### MATERIALS

- › Multi Twist 100g x 2 balls

#### NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- › 1 pair 8mm knitting needles, or size that gives correct tension.
- › A yarn needle.
- › Strong sewing thread for sewing seam (to prevent a bulky seam)

#### TENSION

- › 11 sts and 14 rows to 10 cm over stocking st, using 8mm needles.

#### BEANIE

- › Using 8mm needles, cast on 61 sts.
- › Beg rib – 1st row (RS) – K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.
- › 2nd row – P1, \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.
- › Rep 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 6 cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.
- › Tie a coloured thread at each end of last row to mark foldline for brim.
- › Cont in rib until work measures 23 cm from coloured threads, ending with 2nd row.
- › Shape Crown – 1st row – K1, \* sl 1, K2tog, pssso, rib 3, rep from \* to end = 41 sts.
- › Work 3 rows rib.
- › 5th row – K1, \* sl 1, K2tog, pssso, K1, rep from \* to end = 21 sts.
- › Work 3 rows rib.
- › 9th row – \* sl 1, K2tog, pssso, rep from \* to end = 7 sts.
- › 10th row – Purl.
- › Break off yarn leaving a long end. Run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

#### FINISHING

- › DO NOT PRESS.
- › Darn in ends.
- › Using strong sewing thread and a flat seam, join side edges together.
- › Fold brim onto RS.
