RIB BEANIE BEANIE Easy Knit

RIB BEANIE

BEANIE

MEASUREMENTS

> To fit head (approx) 56 - 58cm

MATERIALS

> Multi Twist 100g x 2 balls

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- $>\!1$ pair 8mm knitting needles, or size that gives correct tension.
- A yarn needle.
- Strong sewing thread for sewing seam (to prevent a bulky seam)

TENSION

> 11 sts and 14 rows to 10 cm over stocking st, using 8mm needles.

BEANIE

- > Using 8mm needles, cast on 61 sts.
- > Beg rib 1st row (RS) K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.
- > 2nd row P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.
- > Rep 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 6 cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.
- Tie a coloured thread at each end of last row to mark foldline for brim.
- > Cont in rib until work measures 23 cm from coloured threads, ending with 2nd row.
- > Shape Crown 1st row K1, * sl 1, K2tog, psso, rib 3, rep from * to end = 41 sts.
- > Work 3 rows rib.
- > 5th row K1, * sl 1, K2tog, psso, K1, rep from * to end = 21 sts.
- > Work 3 rows rib.
- \rightarrow 9th row * sl 1, K2tog, psso, rep from * to end = 7 sts.
- > 10th row Purl.
- > Break off yarn leaving a long end. Run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

FINISHING

- DO NOT PRESS.
- Darn in ends.
- > Using strong sewing thread and a **flat seam**, join side edges together.
- > Fold brim onto RS.
