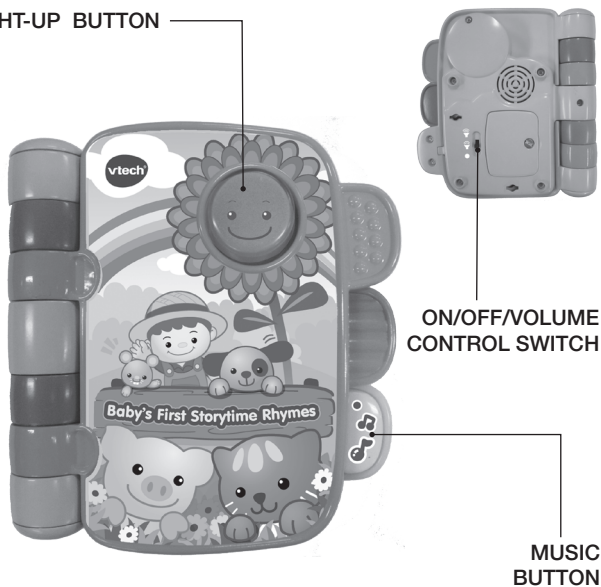

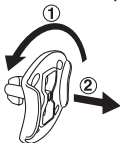

Unlock the packaging locks:

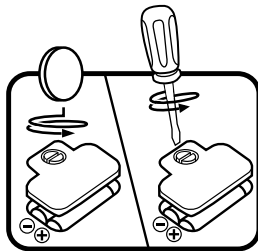


- ① Rotate the packing locks 90 degrees counter-clockwise.
- ② Pull out the packing locks.

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw. Install 2 new 'AAA' batteries following the diagram inside the battery box.
3. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheeled bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in Battery Directive (2006/66/EC).



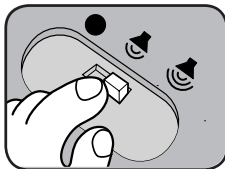

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

To turn the unit **ON**, slide the **ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH** to the **LOW VOLUME** () or **HIGH VOLUME** () position. To turn the unit **OFF**, slide the **ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH** to the **OFF** (●) position.

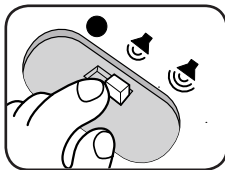


2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the VTech® Baby's First Storytime Rhymes will automatically power down after approximately 30 seconds without input. You will hear a short tune before the unit powers down. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button or by turning the book pages.

ACTIVITIES

1. Slide the **on/off/volume control switch** to turn the unit on. Press a button or turn the book pages to hear a voice or musical response.



2. Press the **light-up button** to hear a short song, a phrase and short tunes when the book is closed. When the book is open, press the light-up button to hear sung songs related to the book pages. The light will flash with the sounds.



3. Press the **music button** to hear short tunes and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.



4. Turn the pages to hear a sound, a phrase and a song related to the pictures on the right side of the book. Close the book to hear a short tune. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
 3. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Please turn the unit OFF.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
5. If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
