Illuminated Beauty Mirror

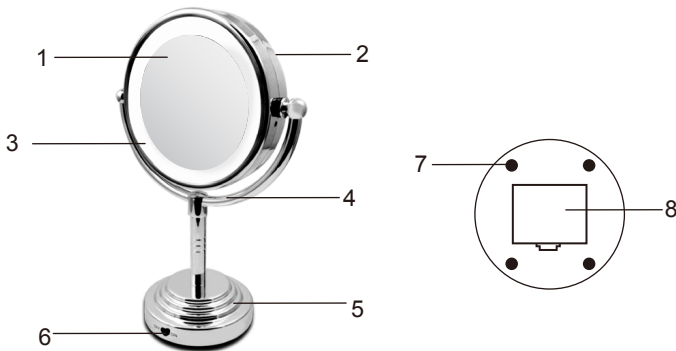

GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Keep this device out of the reach of children. Put it away in a safe place.
- This device is designed for domestic use only.
- Do not use the device if it is broken or damaged.
- Do not use in direct sunlight. Reflected sunlight can cause fire.
- Always switch the device off before changing the batteries.
- Never submerge the device in water or any other liquid.
- To avoid corrosion of the components, never open the battery compartment if the device is wet.
- Never leave dead batteries in the battery compartment. If the batteries leak, damage may be caused to the internal components of the device.
- Never clean the device with detergent products.
- Use this device for the purpose for which it is intended only, as described in these instructions.

1. 1x magnification mirror
2. 5x magnification mirror
3. 8 LEDs inside
4. Mirror tilts for viewing
5. Mirror base
6. ON/OFF switch
7. Protective pads (underneath)
8. Battery compartment (underneath)



INSTALLING / REMOVING BATTERIES

- Your mirror works with 3x AA (1.5 V) batteries.
- Remove the cover of the battery compartment located under the base. Insert 3pcs AA (1.5 V) batteries, making sure to match the polarities as indicated in the battery compartment. Replace the battery compartment cover.
- Before removing the batteries from the device, make sure it is in the “OFF” position. Open the battery compartment cover, remove the batteries and then replace the cover under the mirror base.

USING THE MIRROR

- To activate the mirror’s lighting, turn the switch on the base to the “ON” position. To switch it off, go back to the “OFF” position.
- Turn the mirror to the 1x (regular mirror) side, or for close-ups, turn it to the 3x magnification side.
- Adjust the tilt for convenient viewing.

LOOKING AFTER YOUR MIRROR

- The body of the mirror can be cleaned with a soft, dry cloth. Never use a damp cloth.
- Mirror surfaces must be cleaned with a soft cloth (if necessary using an appropriate cleaning product).
- Store your mirror in a cool, dry place. Remove the batteries if the mirror will not be used for a long time.
- Change the batteries if the light intensity weakens.
- Never expose the device to physical shock, humidity, dust, chemical products or abrupt temperature variations.
- Make sure that direct sunlight does not strike the mirror surface when it is left unattended; reflected sunlight can cause fire.
