INSTALLATION

- 1) Install mounting tool (2) with ceiling hook (1) (not included).
- 2) Connect BC plug adaptor (4) to installed batten holder (3).
- 3) Move batten cover so the top sits flush against the ceiling and tighten support anchor (5).
- 4) Connect the shade(6) to socket and fix with the socket ring(7).
- 5) Install the rated bulb Max 60W B22 -GLS bulb (not included) or Max 42W B22 Halogen bulb (not included) into the lamp holder.


