

MOULD KIT - INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these instructions thoroughly and completely before starting the project.

CONTENTS

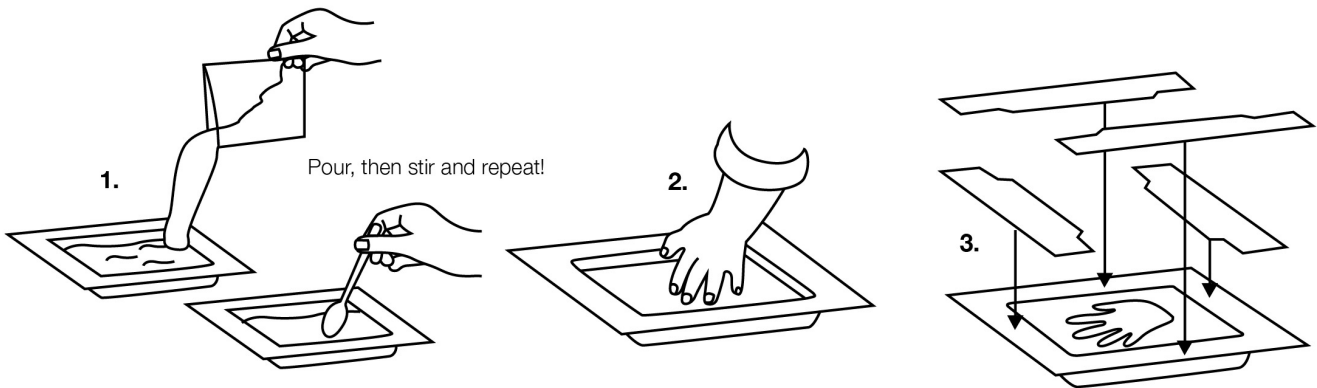
- 2 x bags of plaster
- 2 x plastic moulds
- 3 x sticker sheets
- 8 x cardstock frame pieces
- 2 x cardboard easel backs
- Adhesive foam stickers
- Double sided tape
- Instruction sheet

WARNING

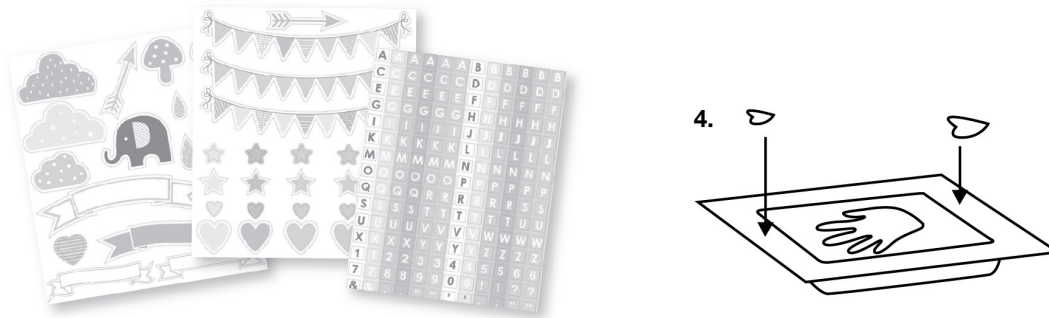
Not suitable for children under 3 years due to small parts, which may present a choking hazard. Ensure clothing and surrounding area is protected from plaster as it may stain. Rinse immediately if any does come into contact. Adult supervision is recommended.

INSTRUCTIONS

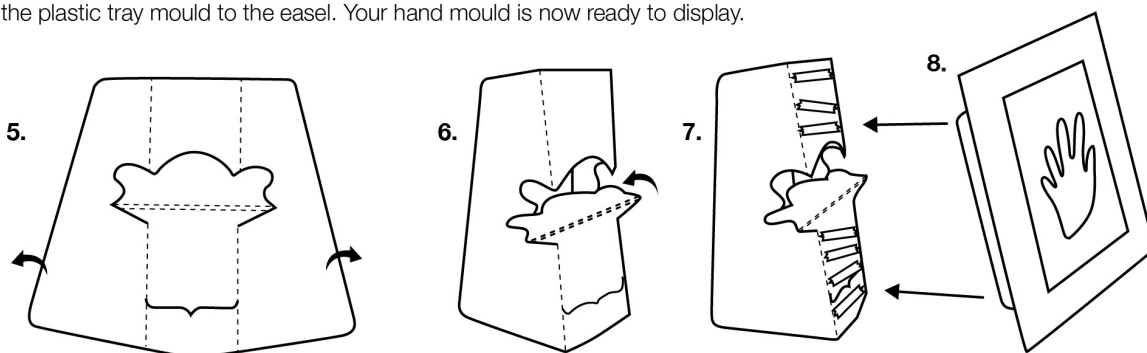
1. Pour 200ml of cool water into one plastic mould. Cut open one plaster bag, then gradually add the plaster powder into the mould and use a spoon to stir the mixture quickly until all the lumps are gone. Repeat to add the remaining plaster powder into the mould for several times until all plaster powder are added.
Note: Only small amounts of plaster powder is to be added each time, using the spoon to stir the mixture quickly until all the lumps have dissolved prior to the next step.
2. Wait 60 seconds then place your child's hand/foot half way into the plaster being sure to keep the hand/foot still for about 1 minute. Carefully remove your child's hand/foot from the plaster and allow the mould to harden.
3. Using double sided tape, peel and stick the frame pieces to the plastic mould edges so the tabs hang over the edge of the mould tray.



4. Select the decorative stickers you want to use and personalize your frame.



5. Select the easel and fold the sides back as shown.
6. Next, fold the centre tab down and back making sure the slots hold the folded sides in place.
7. Liberally apply the double sided tape to the front of the easel.
8. Stick the plastic tray mould to the easel. Your hand mould is now ready to display.



9. Repeat all steps with the leftover bag of plaster to make your second mould!
