Paint Your Own Rock Set



TIPS:

- 1. Add some water to the paints if they look too dry or sticky.
- 2. Let the painted rocks dry completely after you have finished painting.
- 3. Keep the box nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.
- 4. Freely mix up colour to create new ones.

DIRECTIONS 1:

- 1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
- 2. Cover work area with newspapers or paper towels.
- 3. Lay out all of your material in front of you.
- 4. Put on an apron before you paint.
- 5. Keep a cup of water to clean the paint brush after applying each colour.
- 6. Close the paint lid after use.

DIRECTIONS 2:

- 1. Choose which rock to start with and decide the colour you want to use.
- 2. Use the paint brush to paint the rock.
- 3. Select you next colour and use the stick to blend the colours on the rock to create a marble design.
- 4. Set the rock a side until the paint is dry.

Note: Mixing Red and Yellow will make a close shade to Orange.

Mixing Blue and Yellow will make a close shade to Dark Green.
