- · 40 Preset Stations (20 FM, 20 AM)
- Dimmer Control

- Keep the instruction manual for future reference. Should this appliance be given to a third party, then this instruction manual must also be handed over.
- · Use this appliance solely for its intended purpose.
- · This appliance is intended for household use only.
- · Only use this appliance indoors.
- Danger of electroshock! Do not immerse the appliance, power cord or power plug in water or in other liquids.
- Do not place the appliance in the direct vicinity of liquids e.g. bathtubs and sinks, in a damp basement or close to a swimming pool.
- Do not start up the appliance with damp hands or if you are standing on a wet floor.
- · Never grasp the power plug with damp or wet hands.





#### BEFORE FIRST USE

- Unpack the appliance and check if all parts are there and undamaged. Should this
  not be the case, return the product to Kmart for replacement.
- · Danger of suffocation! Keep all packaging materials away from children.
- Dispose of the packaging materials properly. Inform yourself at the local authorities regarding collection points or garbage separation.
- · Remove all protective foils and packaging material prior to use.

# POWER SUPPLY

- Connect the AC/DC adapter with a suitable electrical outlet. Make sure that the power supply voltage is the same as needed for the AC/DC adapter.
- Connect the micro-USB DC end of the AC/DC adapter with the DC 5V port (12), the LED light (9) will turn on (red).

#### BASIC OPERATIONS

#### Standby / Power on

- After connecting the power supply, the unit will be in Standby mode.
- To get into standby mode without disconnecting the AC/DC adapter, press and hold the Standby button (2) for two seconds. The LED display (1) will turn off in Standby mode.

## Changing working modes

Press Standby button (2) repeatedly to change working modes:
 Clock, Alarm, FM radio, or AM radio.

#### Display mode

 Press the Standby (1) button to switch the radio function on. The display will show the current radio frequency for five seconds and then the current time.

#### Dimmer control

· Press DIMMER button (5) to toggle the brightness level of display (1).

#### Volume control

 In FM/AM radio mode, press Shift (4) button to display the current volume, e.g. U22 (Vol 22), then press the VOL + (8) and VOL - (7) buttons to adjust the volume level.

#### Changing time display mode

 In Clock mode, press and hold SET (6) button for 2 seconds to toggle time display mode between 12-hour and 24-hour

#### **SETTINGS**

Note: Press and hold the VOL + (8) and VOL - (7) buttons for fast-changing of settings.

#### Setting the Clock

(Applies in Clock mode only)

- 1. Press SET button (6), and the number of hour will flash.
- 2. Press the VOL + (8) and VOL (7) buttons to change the setting of hour.
- 3. Press the SET button (6) to confirm the setting of hour, the number of minute will flash.
- 4. Press the VOL + (8) and VOL (7) buttons to change the setting of minute.
- Press the SET button (6) to confirm the clock time setting, or do not press any button for a few seconds, the hour / minute digits stop flashing and the set time shows in the display (1).

#### Note:

. The AM or PM will display when the time display mode is set as 12-hour.

#### Setting Alarms 1 to 4

- 1. Press Standby (2) button to switch to Alarm mode, 'ALA1' will display.
- Press VOL + (8) and VOL (7) buttons to select your desired alarm number 1-4 to set, it's current waking up mode settings will display, press VOL + (8) and VOL - (7) buttons to select one of the following options:
  - · BEEP: Set buzzer as alarm bells, ringing for 1 minute:
  - · Fn (FM radio): Set last radio station as alarm sound, lasting for 3 minutes;
  - . OFF: Turn off the alarm.
- Press SET (6) button to confirm the selection, and the number of hours will flash, prompting you to set it.
- Press VOL + (8) and VOL (7) buttons to set the hours of alarm time, then press SET (6) button to confirm the setting, and the number of minutes will flash, prompting you to set it.
- Press VOL + (8) and VOL (7) buttons to set the minutes of alarm time, then press SET (6) button to confirm and exit the settings.
- 6. The unit will then return to the clock time display after five seconds.

#### Note:

. The Alarm 1-4 logos will display when they are set as Beep or FM radio.

#### Waking up with Buzzer or Radio Sound

- When the preset alarm time is reached, the alarm will sound in the selected mode.
- To stop the alarm, press any button except SNOOZE. The alarm will sound again at the same time the next day.

#### Note:

The beep alarm volume is fixed and cannot be adjusted.

#### **Disabling Alarm Functions**

- Press Alarm On/Off (3) button to turn off all alarms, it will display "OFF" for several seconds, and all the alarm indicators will disappear.
- Press Alarm On/Off (3) button again to resume your alarm settings, and it will display "ON" for several seconds, and the alarm indicators will display when they were previously set as "ON".

#### Snooze Function

- When the alarm sounds, press the SNOOZE button (7 & 8) to stop the alarm temporarily.
   The Alarm indicator will flash, and the alarm will sound again after 5 minutes.
- To cancel the SNOOZE function and repeat the alarm the next day, press any button except SNOOZE,

#### Sleep Function

This function allows you to program the unit so that the radio switches off automatically after a certain period of time (up to 120 minutes).

- In AM/FM radio mode, press and hold SET button (6) repeatedly to select the period
  of time (in minute) after which the clock radio will turn off automatically. The SLEEP
  indicator will display.
- 2. When the preset sleep duration has elapsed, the radio turns off automatically.
- To cancel the sleep function before the preset time elapses, press and hold the Standby (2) button to turn the radio off immediately.

#### RADIO OPERATION

#### Listening to the Radio

- Press Standby (2) button to power on the clock radio, and press again to enter into AM or FM mode.
- For automatic tuning, press and hold the TUNE + button (8) and TUNE button (7) for two seconds. Release the button, the tuner will scan and stop for the first strong station. Reneat until the desired station is reached.
- For manual fine-tuning, press the same buttons repeatedly to adjust the frequency step by step.

#### Achieving Optimum Reception

- 1. In FM mode, extend and position the wire FM antenna to achieve optimum reception.
- In AM mode, rotate the unit to achieve optimum reception.

#### Preset Radio Stations

You can store up to 20 stations each for FM and AM.

- 1. Go to your desired station.
- Press and hold the SET button (6) for two seconds, the program number will flash in
  the display. Press TUNE + button (8) and TUNE button (7) to change the program
  number where you would like to store the station. Press and hold SET (6) again to
  confirm the setting.
- 3. Repeat steps 1-2 to store any other desired stations.

#### Listen to a Preset Station

 When listening to the radio, press the SET (6) button repeatedly to select a preset radio station

# **CLEANING AND CARE**

Danger of electroshock! Do not immerse the appliance in water or in other liquids.

- 1. Always pull the plug and remove the battery before storage.
- 2. Wipe the housing with a dry, soft cloth.
- 3. Do not use petrol, alcohol or other abrasive cleaners to clean the device.
