

Paint Your Own Safari Animals

DIRECTIONS:

1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
2. Cover work area with newspaper or paper towel.
3. Lay out all of your material in front of you.
4. Put on an apron before you paint.
5. Keep a cup of water to clean the paint brush after applying each colour.
6. Close the paint lid after use.

TIPS:

1. Add some water to the paints if they look too dry or sticky.
2. Let the painted plaster dry completely after you have finished painting.
3. Keep the box nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.
4. Freely mix up colours to create new ones.

Note: Mixing White and Black will make a close shade to Grey.
Mixing Orange and Brown will make a close shade to Khaki.
Mixing White, Black and Brown will make a close shade to Taupe.
