Make Your Own Farm Plaster Set

5+

How To Mould

CONTENTS:

- 2 x 100g bags of plaster
- 1 x 6 character mould tray
- 1 x carving tool
- 1 x bowl
- 6 x 2mL paint pots
- 1 x paint brush

SET UP:

1. Put down some newspaper or plastic covering on a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
2. Put on an apron or a smock to protect your clothing.
3. Have all tools you need at the work area.


DIRECTIONS:

STEP 1



Pour the plaster powder into the bowl and add small parts of water at a time while stirring with a spoon (not included) until it forms a paste-like consistency. You will need to stir the plaster quickly, as it will normally start to harden in 5-10 minutes.

STEP 2



Quickly pour the plaster mixture into the mould tray and gently agitate the mould to eliminate air bubbles. Allow 24 hours to dry. Drying times may vary. Make sure the plaster feels dry.

STEP 3



Once the plasters are dry, gently tap the outside of the tray and release the shaped plasters out. Be careful to avoid breakage. Use the carving tool to smooth the edges. You are now ready to paint your shaped plasters.

How To Paint

DIRECTIONS:

1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
2. Cover work area with newspaper or paper towel.
3. Lay out all of your material in front of you.
4. Put on an apron before you paint.
5. Keep a cup of water to clean the paint brush after applying each colour.
6. Close all paint lids after use.

TIPS:

1. Add some water to the paints if they look too dry or sticky.
2. Let the painted plaster dry completely after you have finished painting.
3. Keep the box nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.
4. Freely mix up colours to create new colours.

Note: Mixing Yellow and Red will make a close shade to Orange.

Mixing White and Black will make a close shade to Gray.

Mixing White, Yellow and Brown will make a close shade to Light Khaki.

Mixing White, Yellow and Red will make a close shade to Meat Pink.
