INTRODUCTION

Many of their origins can be found in traditional myths and legends whilst others are thought to be based on real creatures from confused accounts from medieval travellers.

START DIGGING!

STEP 1:

Cover your work area with news papers or large sheets of paper and wear old clothes or a smock. Make sure your working area is an easy to clean surface. Place your block in the middle of your work area.

STEP 2:

Using the chisel and hammer, carefully dig into the clay eggs and carve out the myths & legends hidden inside.

STEP 3:

During the digging process, use the brush to brush away any remaining clay or dust. Don't blow the dust away.

TIP: If you have a spray bottle, fill it with water and keep it close by to dampen the egg for an easier dig. As an alternative, you can submerge the egg into water for a minute.

***Dispose of clay in the trash. Do not put clay powder into the sink or bath tub drain as it may clog.

STEP 4:

Gather all of the myths and legends and display them on your desk or maybe even on a window sill. See if you can identify the what kind of creature they all are too!
