To assemble Frame...

1

1a. Insert side frame into one side of one end panel.



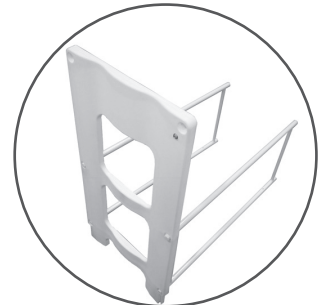

2a. Insert two bolts and secure using plastic assembly tool.
2b. Do not tighten completely.

3a. Insert second side frame into end panel and secure with bolts, using plastic assembly tool. Do not tighten bolts completely.

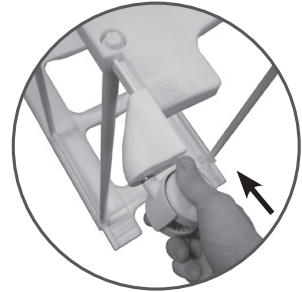
4a. Repeat to attach second end panel.



To assemble Frame continued...

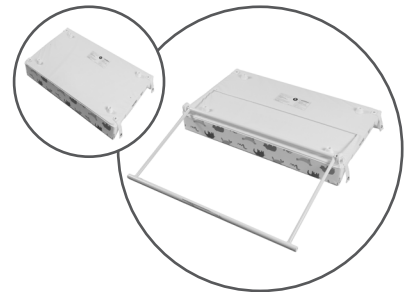
- 5a. Lay Change Centre flat on the floor.
- 5b. Slide Castors onto end panels. Ensure Castors are pointing down.

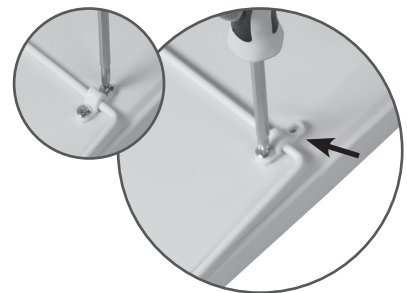
- 6a. Lay **Change Pad** face down on a flat surface.
- 6b. Lay **Change Pad Assembly Arm** onto the **Change Pad**.

NOTE: Ensure the metal loops are facing up and that the horizontal bar sits between the pre-drilled holes on the Change Pad.



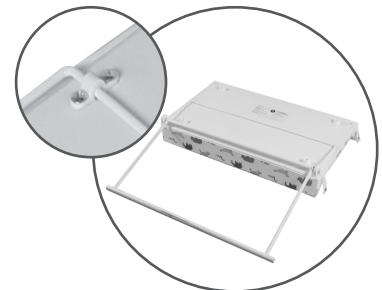

- 7a. Attach one **Assembly Arm Fixing** over the horizontal bar of the **Change Pad Assembly Arm**.
- 7b. Secure with 2 x **10mm Screws**.

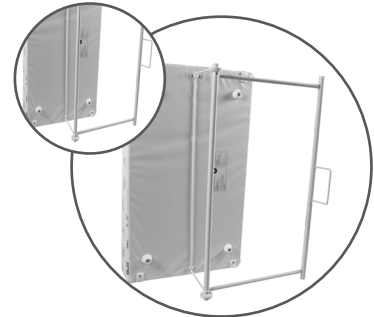
- 8a. Repeat for other side



To assemble Frame continued...

9

- 9a. With Change Centre still lying on its side, insert Change Pad Assembly between the two Side Panels and into the top holes.
- 9b. Ensure the 'U' bar on the front of the assembly is pointing down toward the ground to ensure Change Pad can be operated correctly.



10

- 10a. Insert one **Assembly Bolt** into the front side hole and secure using the **Assembly Tool**.
- 10b. Insert one **Assembly Bolt** into the back side hole and secure using the **Assembly Tool**.
- 10c. Repeat for other side.



11

- 11a. Stand Change Centre upright.
- 11b. Connect press studs on **Change Pad** webbing with press studs on **Side Panel**.
- 11c. Tighten all bolts until firm.



To attach Bottom Shelf...

1

- 1a. Place bottom shelf in position as shown.
- 1b. Fold up sides and attach end flaps around vertical bars of side panels, using press studs to secure as shown.



To assemble Plastic Components...

1

- 1a. Place the three storage containers into position on the upper rails of the side frames, creating a shelf in the centre of the unit.



To assemble Plastic Components...

2

- 2a. Place the left component of the side tray into position, then place the right component ensuring it clips into the left component as shown. Ensure the side tray rests against the bar on the top frame.



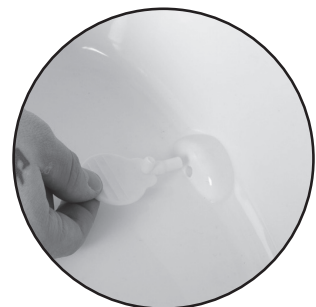

- 3a. Place bathtub into position as shown

- 4a. Insert plug into bath drain hole.

To lower Change Pad...

- 1a. Disengage change pad press studs.



Change Pad Operation...

To lower Change Pad...

2a. Lift **Change Pad** and lower backwards over the Change Centre.



To raise Change Pad...

1

1a. Lift **Change Pad** up and pull into position.

2a. Engage change pad press studs.



Bath Drainage...

1

1a. Locate Bath drainage hole on underside of Bath .
1b. Connect Drain Hose to drainage hole.
