- 3. Place all the game pieces in a pile next to the game base, and give them a good mix-up, so all the pieces are randomly spread around.
- 4. Make sure the Start/Stop lever is in the Stop ("O") position. Diagram B.
- 5. Press down on the center section of pizza until it locks in place at lowered position. Press simultaneously at the 2 areas with small round holes. Diagram C.
- 6. Turn the timer to the starting position, so the number 60 is next to the triangle. Diagram D.
- 7. You're ready to play!

How to play:

- 1. Flip the Start / Stop lever to "Start"(" I ") to begin the countdown timer. Diagram E.
- 2. Race against the timer to place all the toppings in their correct positions.
- 3. If you are able to place all the toppings in their correct positions before time runs out, flip the Start / Stop lever to "Stop" and check the time remaining.
- 4. Mark down how much time was remaining for your turn.
- 5. If time is running out before you can place all the toppings on the pizza, time to panic, because the pizza's going to POP!
- 6. If each player is successful in placing all the toppings on the pizza and stopping the timer, the player with the most time remaining on the clock wins!

Note to parents:

- 1. For younger children, try playing the game without the timer.
- 2. This will allow the children to get used to shape recognition, without the frustration of not completing the game in time.
- 3. The challenge of the timer can be introduced once you feel confident your child has learned where the shaped pieces go.

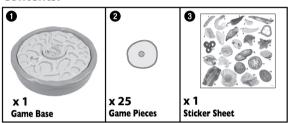

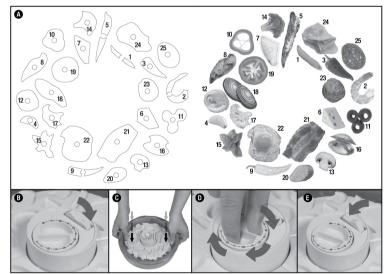
