

Paint Your Own Mini Ceramic Tea Set



DIRECTIONS:

1. Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area.
2. Cover work area with newspaper or paper towel.
3. Lay out all of your material in front of you.
4. Put on an apron or art smock before you paint.
5. Keep a cup of water to clean the paint brush after applying each colour.
6. Close the paint lid after use.

TIPS:

1. Add some water to the paints if they look too dry or sticky.
2. Allow the tea set to cool completely before use.
3. Keep the box nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.
4. Freely mix up colour to create new ones.
5. If you make a mistake when you are painting, just wipe the paint off with a tissue or wash the tea set. However, the paint cannot be washed or wiped off easily after baking.

HOW TO HEAT THE SET IN THE OVEN:

1. Clean the tea set with a cloth. Then paint on it with the paintbrush.
2. After you have finished painting, dry the tea set for 1 day.
3. Place the tea set in an oven(normal gas or electrical), but NOT a microwave.
4. Heat the tea set in the oven with temperature of 100°C /212 °F for around 25 minutes. Do not take it out immediately.
5. After cooling off, take the tea set out of your oven.
6. Your tea set is now complete!

CAUTION:

1. Before you place the tea set in the oven, ensure it has dried for 24 hours after you have finished painting. Paint colours will be dull if it is not completely dry.
2. Ensure to let your tea set cool down before removing it from the oven as it is very hot.
3. Only use a normal gas or electrical oven, NOT a microwave.
