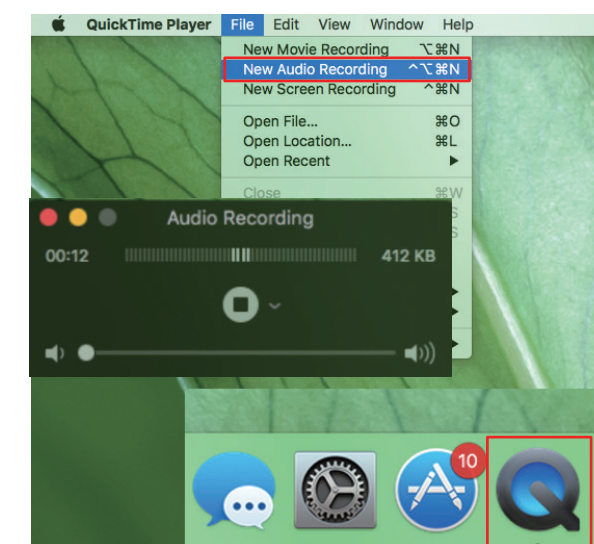
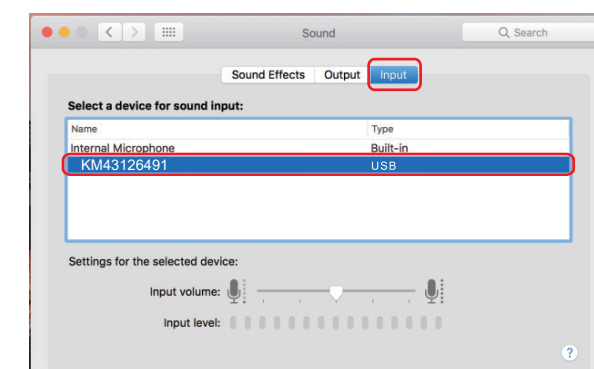
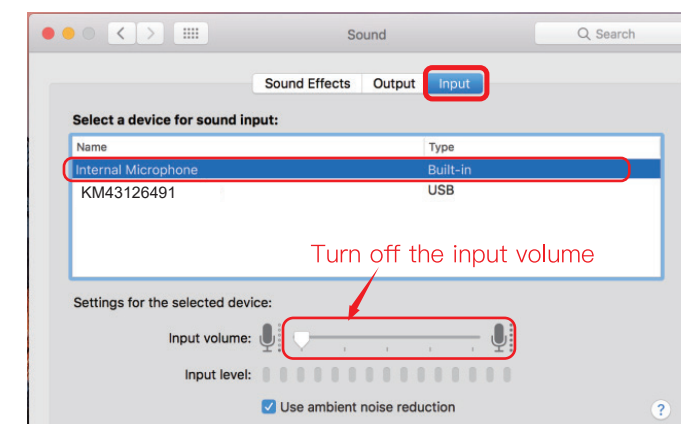
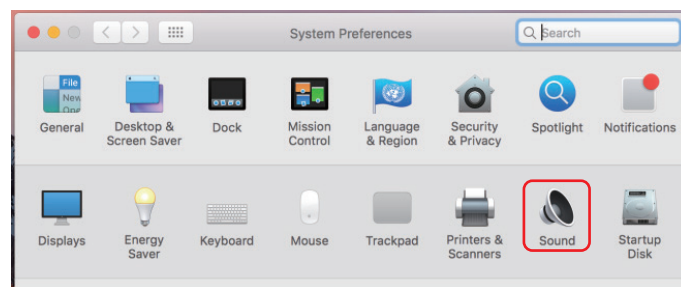
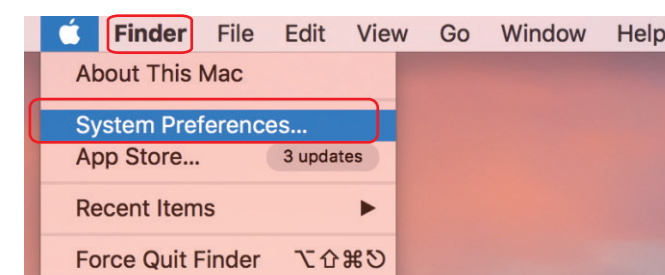
Windows 7/8/10 Installation for USB

1. Plug USB port of the microphone directly into your laptop or desktop computer.
2. Right click the **Audio Manager icon** on the lower right of the desktop, then click the recording devices.
3. See the microphone is set up and is on default, double click on **microphone**, then you can find internal microphone properties and click it.
4. Click the **listen**, then click the **OK button** (If ou need to monitor when recording, click **OK** to save the settings).
5. Click the **custom**, you can choose whether there is **AGC** based on your personal preference.
6. Click the **levels**, you can adjust the volume based on your personal preference.
7. Click **OK** to save the setting, then start to use this microphone.



Mac OS for USB

1. Click the desktop menu, then click system preferences.
2. Find **sound button** and click it.
3. Choose **input**, you will find internal microphone, turn off the input volume.
4. Choose **KM43126491** adjust input volume (Generally adjust in the middle).
5. Test the microphone sound: search out the computer comes with the software: **Quick Time player**.
6. Right click and select **"New Audio recording"**
7. After selecting the external USB microphone, click the **recording button** and you can record it.



How to install

Mount the microphone over the central pole of the tripod, then rotate the tripod stand as below direction shown to fix the microphone



How to use

1. Press Mute button, Polar Pattern Indicator will change to red color, the power on.
2. Plug earphones to the AUX port, then you could listen to the music or record your voice, etc.
3. Turn the Volume controller to increase or decrease volume based on your need.
4. Press Mute button, and Polar Pattern Indicator will go off.
