
## **Beading Set**

### 5+ years


### TIPS:

- After tying the thread in a loop knot, tape the knotted end on your table to prevent the thread from sliding out. (tape not included)
- 2. Make sure the thread lay flat and not twisted.
- 3. Slide the beads through the base thread or side thread then continue knotting.
- 4. Make sure the tension is distributed evenly between the thread.
- 5. Keep the package nearby so that you can look at the picture for inspiration.


### INSTRUCTIONS:




Fold one thread in half and tie the folded strand into a loop knot 10cm from the end.




Divide the thread into two strands and slide two beads on each stand.




Treat the two stands as a single thread and slide one bead on, pulling the beads to be close together.



Repeat the process until the length can wrap loosely around your wrist.




Tie a knot, then you are finished.




Slide four same colour beads on the thread as the flower petal.




Then add a different coloured bead on the thread.




Thread the top end of the cord through the first beads in the opposite way.




Slide the right side through the two beads in same petal colour.



Then thread the cord through the forth beads.



Pull the thread lightly to make the beads turn into a flower shape.



Slide more beads on and repeat the process until the length can wrap loosely around your wrist.



Tie a knot, then you are finished.
