


Cut a 50cm length of yarn (2 lengths of the ruler on the right) for each notch in the petals on the wheel in the corresponding colour. For example, for the heart design cut 10 red yarn that are 50cm long and 6 yellow yarn that are 50cm long.




Line up the ends of all the yarn and tie them in a knot.

Divide the yarn in half and put them around a pencil (not included)! Take all of the yarn together and tie them in a knot close to the pencil.

Slip the loop you just made off the pencil. This loop will hold the bracelet on your wrist!

Place the loop in the center of the wheel. Now pull out each yarn and hook it into the notch of the matching coloured petal.



To create your bracelet you will need to unhook one yarn at a time and rehook it in another notch. Every pattern works the same way!



Find the start arrow and rotate it to the top of the wheel.



Unhook the string from the right notch...



Notice that you skipped three petals to get to the bottom peta!


...and rehook it into the notch to the right of the petal directly below the top one.



See how the yarn creates a group of three?



Unhook the yarn on the left of the group...



...and rehook it up to the notch on the left of the single yarn.



Rotate your wheel counter-clockwise so that the next petal is at the top. Repeat steps 1-5 and watch your bracelet grow like magic!
