


① Put the location holes card on the wall which you would like to hang the lamp. Use pencil or marker pen (not included) to locate 3 holes.


(2) Drill holes at the located position by pistol drill (not included). Make sure the drill diameter is 5-5.2mm and holes depth are deeper than 30mm.




③ Insert the expansion bolts into the holes. Use hammer (not included) to make it smooth on the wall.




④ Install the metal screws into the expansion bolts. Please make sure there is 3-5mm gap between metal screw and expansion bolt for hanging.
