2. BLUETOOTH Mode

> Select Bluetooth from main interface or press the Bluetooth button on control panel

or remote directly to enter Bluetooth mode

Turn on the Bluetooth feature on your portable device. Find and pair with the "KM43183388" speaker.

Music playback via your device.

→ Press the PLAY/PAUSE button or "MI" button to play or pause.

→ Press PREVIOUS/NEXT button or " ■ "/" ■ " button to select a specific track for playback.

> Remote cannot adjust volume when in BT mode.

> Repeat function and R/L function not valid when in BT mode.

Insert your USB stick or TF card, the screen will auto enter to explorer mode, press RETURN button to return to main interface and connect microphone.

• Select Record feature from interfcae or press record button on remote directly.

> Before record, press PREVIOUS / NEXT button or " ◀ "/" ▶ " button to select "Quality" and "Type", you can select Good/Normal/Poor voice quality and WAV/MP3

Then Press the PLAY/PAUSE or "MI" to start and stop record.

> After recording stops, press PREVIOUS / NEXT button or "◀"/" ▶" button to select "Save" to save your record.

→ Press PREVIOUS/NEXT button or " ◀ "/" ▶ " button to select "List", select your record

**Note:** The "RECORD" function only can recording voice from Microphone source.

4. PHOTO Mode

Insert your USB stick or TF card (with photos inside), the screen will auto enter to explorer mode, press RETURN button to return to main interface.

> Select PHOTO feature from main interface or press photo button on remote directly. → Press the PLAY/PAUSE button or "➡" button to start or stop photo auto-playback.

→ Press PREVIOUS/NEXT button or " ◀ "/" ▶ " button to review the photo one by one. > Supports JPG, JPEG, PNG format.

5. EXPLORER

Insert your USB stick or TF card, the screen will auto enter EXPLORER mode.

You also can select EXPLORER feature from main interface or press explorer button on remote directly at any time.

→ Press PREVIOUS/NEXT button or " ◀ "/" ▶ " button to select USB/TF card to browse the file (Video/Audio/Photo/Record,etc).

Press the MENU button to delete the selected file then press the PLAY/PAUSE or " M button to confirm.

6. AUX INPUT

> Connect an AUX Cable to the AUX-IN JACK of the unit and to your external audio device (e.g MP3 player/mobile phone), then the screen will auto enter AUX mode

You also can select AUX feature from main interface or press AUX IN button on remote to enter AUX mode directly.

> Music playback via your external audio device.

> Select SETTING from main interface or press Setting button on remote directly. > Press PREVIOUS/NEXT or " ◀ "/" ▶ " button to select specific item.

→ Press the PLAY/PAUSE or "►NTER" button to change the option.

Microphone Use Instruction

You can connect the wired microphone through MIC IN jack or turn on the wireless microphone to use directly.

• The wireless microphone and wired microphone can be used at the same time. • When speaking with MIC and playing music at the same time, press MIC FIRST, music


will turn to min volume automatically, and mic volume will be clearer. The MIC Volume can be adjusted through MIC Volume knob on the control panel.

The ECHO effects can be adjusted through ECHO knob on the control panel. • Please do not get too close to the speaker when using the microphone.

Turn off the microphone when not in use.

Pull Rod instruction

Press and hold (A) button and pull out to make trolley longer. The height can be adjusted from 25.5cm to 44cm.
