







INSTRUCTIONS

Getting Started

Before starting a bracelet make sure to gather and organise all of your supplies. Line up your beads in the order you would like to bead them.

Braiding:

STEP 1: Cut three 30cm cotton cords. Tie them altogether into a knot at one end and tape them down.

STEP 2: Imagine you are braiding hair. Take the left strand and cross it over the middle. Take the right strand and cross it over the middle. Next take the right strand and cross it over the middle. Repeat this pattern for 2cm.

STEP 3: Thread a small bead onto the left strand and push it tightly to the top of the braid. Cross the left strand over the middle.

STEP 4: Add a small bead to the right strand and push it tightly to the top of the braid. Cross the right strand over the middle.

Repeat steps 3-4.

STEP 5: If you would like to personalise your bracelet with a name or word you will need to complete 5 rows of small beads until you add your letters or charms. To keep the letters in a straight line make sure to braid them only on the left strand whilst adding single coloured small beads to the right side.

TIP: It will help if your bracelet is laid down flat when you braid.

STEP 6: Repeat steps 3 & 4 to frame your words symmetrically.

STEP 7: When you have finished adding beads continue making a braid using just the cording. Make sure the bracelet fits. Secure by tying a knot.

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Beading:

STEP 1: Cut a length of cord that will fit around your wrist and have enough slack to tie.

STEP 2: Tie the cord at one end into a knot so that the beads will not fall off when threaded. You may need to double or triple your knot.

STEP 3: Thread a bead of your choice onto the cord.

STEP 4: Add any of the beads, charms or pearls onto the cord to create a cool bracelet design.

STEP 5: When threading on the beads, pearls or charms try to do so in a way that will give you the same amount of beads/pearls either side of your charm. This will balance the design and make sure the charm hangs centrally.

TIP: It will help if your bracelet is flat laid down when you braid.

STEP6: Once your happy with your design tie the ends of the cord together creating a bracelet and slide onto your wrist.

Loosely line up your beads in the order you would like to bead them.

Step 1: Measure the string to the size you wish your bracelet to be with enough slack to tie at the end.

Step 2: Thread the beads you want onto the string. It's a good idea to alternate between silver flowers, silver beads and coloured beads.

Step 3: Add charms to your bracelet for some extra sparkle! Tip: When adding a star charm be sure to add a smaller bead next to it to balance the bracelet.



Step 4: Once you are done placing your beads on the string take the two ends of the string and make a knot.
