Instructions




Step 1: Prepare 5 x 90cm cords, 1 wooden bead and 1 key chain. Fold all cords in half and knot onto the ring as shown.




Step 2: There will be 10 cords hanging from the ring with the same length as shown.




Step 3: Take the 1st cord on the right side as a core cord and tie a knot with the 2nd cord as shown, in the direction from right to center.




Step 4: Take the core cord again (repeating step 3) and tie a 2nd knot as shown. Every cord will make 2 knots with core cord.




Step 5: Repeat steps 3-4 to finish tying the knot on the cord side. Note: The right part needs to repeat steps 3-4 four times to complete.




Step 6: Now repeat steps 3-5 in the opposite direction for the left side. Take the 1st cord on the left side as a core cord and tie a knot with the 2nd cord as shown, in the direction from left to center.




Step 7: Take the core cord again (repeating step 5) and tie a 2nd knot as shown. Every cord will make 2 knots with core cord.




Step 8: 1st row of macrame is complete as shown.




Step 9: Begin knots for 2nd row of left side by repeating step 6-7.




Step 10: Repeat a 3rd row of knots on the left. Then add 2nd and 3rd row of knots to the right side.




Step 11: Top section of macrame is complete as shown.




Step 12: Take the wooden bead and thread it onto the 2 center cords as shown.




Step 13: Beginning in the center, repeat steps 3-7, tying knots outwards from the center.




Step 14: Make 3 rows of knots on each side. Complete each row of knots on each side by repeating steps 3-4 with four knots as shown.




Step 15: Using the 4 center cords, tie a knot as shown.



Step 16: Tie a 2nd knot in the opposite direction as shown and tighten it.



Step 17: Continue to tie the 3rd knot in the same direction of step 15 as shown and tighten it.



Step 18: Use a comb to brush through the cord ends to create a fringed effect. From the ends neatly to 1cm in length to complete the macrame keyring.

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Instructions


Prepare cords:
Cut 8 x 16cm cords, 8 x 14cm cords, 8 x 12cm cords, 1 x 30cm cord.




Step 1: Fold the 30cm cord in half and tie the knot onto keyring as shown.




Step 2: Take 2 x 16cm cords and knot at the top of the core cords as shown.



Step 3: Below the first knot, repeat step 2 using 16cm cords again. Keep repeating using remaining cords from longest at top to shortest at bottom.



Step 4: Use a comb to brush through the cord ends to create a fringed effect.




Step 5: Trim the ends neatly to complete the macrame keyring.

Instructions



Step 1: Prepare 1pc 60cm cord, 4pc 10cm cord and 1 key chain. Fold 4 x 10cm cords in half and knot onto the ring as shown.



Step 2: There will be 8 cords hanging from the ring as shown. Take the 1st cord on the left side as a core cord and tie a knot with the 2nd cord as shown, in the direction from left to center.



Step 3: Take the core cord again (repeating step 2) and tie a 2nd knot as shown. Every cord will make 2 knots with core cord.



Step 4: Repeat step 2 & 3 four times to complete the left side.




Step 5: Now repeat steps 3-5 in the opposite direction for the right side. Take the 1st cord on the right side as a core cord and tie a knot with the 2nd cord as shown, in the direction from right to center.



Step 6: Take the core cord again (repeating step 5) and tie a 2nd knot as shown. Every cord will make 2 knots with core cord.




Step 7: 1st row of macrame is complete as shown.




Step 8: Take the core rope in the center (repeating step 6) and tie a knot with other center cord to the left of the core cord as shown.




Step 9: Repeat step 8 and make a second knot with the same two center cords as shown.




Step 10: Begin knots for 2nd row of left side by repeating step 2-4.



Step 11: 2nd row of macrame is complete for the left side as shown.



Step 12: Repeating the steps, continue to make a total of 6 rows of knots for each side as shown.




Step 13: Take the 60cm cord and fold in half. Loop around the bottom of the macrame section as shown. Leaving a cord end of 1cm at the bottom and the long cord will wrap around to pull cords together.




Step 14: Wrap cords 3-4 times and tighten it, then thread the cord through the loop as shown. Note: Tighten the top section of the cord in the direction of the ambe.



Step 15: Tighten the cord end as shown and trim excess cord.



Step 16: Use a comb to brush through the cord ends to create a fringed effect.



Step 17: Trim the ends neatly to complete the macrame keyring.

Instructions



Step 1: Prepare 1 metal ring with key chain, 1pc 30cm cord, 1pc 10cm gold cord, 1pc 100cm rose cord and 3 x 3 sets of white cotton ropes - 20cm, 17cm and 15cm.



Step 2: Take the three 17cm ropes and begin 3-4cm from the end as shown.



Step 3: Place the short cord end as shown, and start wrapping to cover the cord end.



Step 4: Continue wrapping until you reach 10cm in length.



Step 5: Tie a knot to secure the end as shown.



Step 6: Tighten the knot and trim the excess cord.



Step 7: Take the three 15cm ropes and 100cm rose cord and repeat step 3-6 wrapping process. Leave 3-4cm on each end, creating 8.5cm of wrapped section.



Step 8: Take the remaining three 20cm ropes and 10cm gold cord and repeat step 3-6 wrapping process. When you reach the center attach the metal ring as shown. (Cable is approximately 7cm of wrapping)



Step 9: Continue wrapping another 7cm, creating a total of 16cm of wrapped section and 3-4cm from each end.



Step 10: The 16cm wrapped arch is complete as shown, with metal ring at the top.



Step 11: Place 3 wrapped ropes in order as shown.



Step 12: Bend the gold and mint ropes into an arch shape as shown and secure with glue between each wrapped rope.



Step 13: The first 2 arches a row complete as shown.



Step 14: Apply glue on top of the gold arch in a line across the whole wrapped section.



Step 15: Attach the 16cm arch to the top, pressing firmly.



Step 16: The rainbow shape is now complete as shown.



Step 17: Hold the rainbow together and allow glue to dry.



Step 18: Add the key chain to the metal ring to complete your wrapped rainbow keyring.
