

DIY Clay Trinket Tray

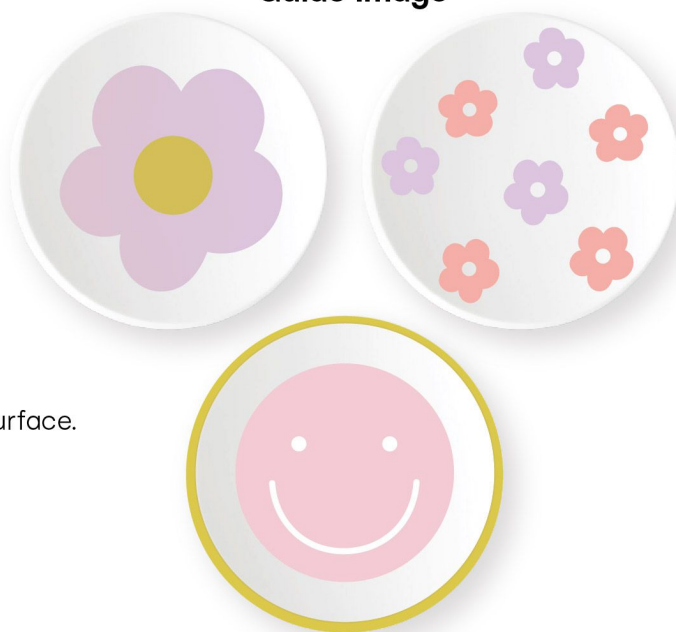
Kit Includes

- > 1 x 450g air dry clay
- > 7 x acrylic paints
- > 1 x paint brush
- > 1 x bottle of glaze
- > 1 x modelling tool
- > 1 x instruction sheet

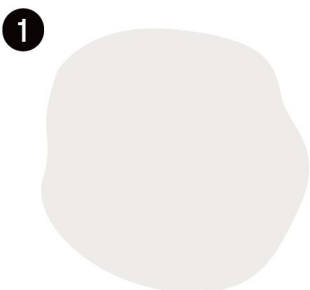
Tips

- Set up your workspace with a place mat to protect your surface.
- Use water to smooth your clay.
- If you prefer a matte finish, do not apply the glaze.

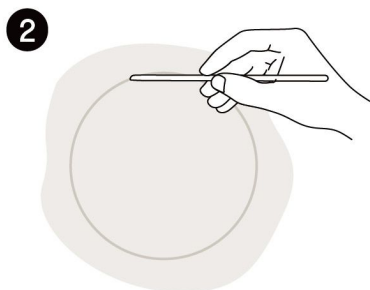

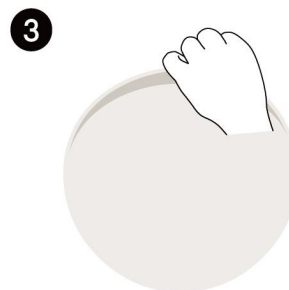
How To Make A Trinket Tray



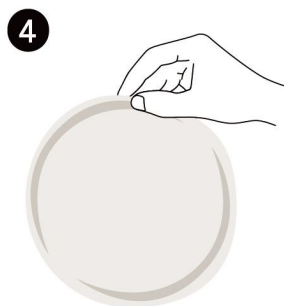
Take one third of the air dry clay and use your hands to press it flat, around 1cm thick.



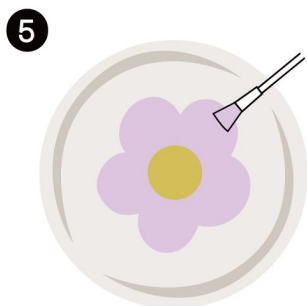
Cut a round shape with the modelling tool, around 9cm diameter.



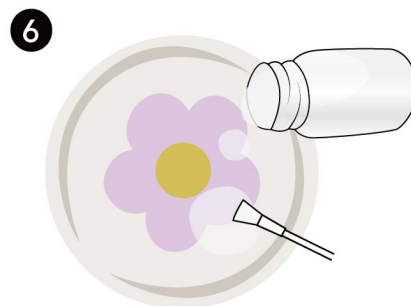
Remove the excess clay from around your cut shape. Use your fingers to mould the edges of the trinket tray, creating a rim all the way around.



Use some water to smooth the clay, then lay the trinket tray on a flat surface to dry overnight.



Paint the vase with your desired pattern and leave to dry.



Pour a small amount of glaze onto the trinket tray and use the paint brush to spread all over.
