

DIY Marbling Pots

Kit Includes

- › 2 x ceramic pots
- › 4 x marbling paints
- › 2 x plastic gloves
- › 1 x marbling powder
- › 1 x plastic stick
- › 1 x instruction sheet

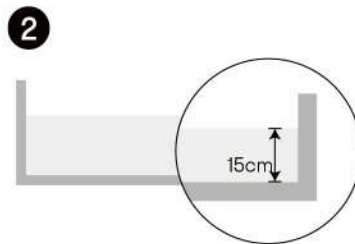
Tips

- Cover your workspace with a plastic sheet or similar to protect your surface.
- Marbling tray size should allow for liquid to sit 15cm deep.
- Wearing gloves is recommended.
- Remove bubbles with the plastic stick provided.
- Marbling liquid takes 3 hours to thicken. Allow time to prepare the liquid in advance.

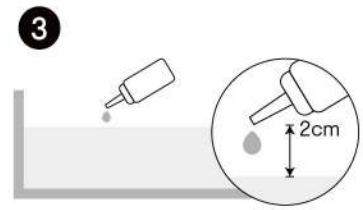
How To Make A Marbling Pot



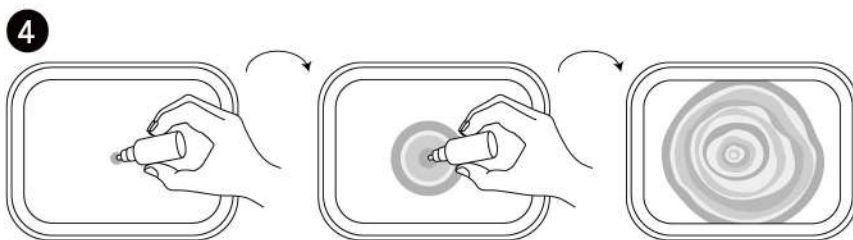
Pour 2.5 litres of water in a container (not included). Add all of the marbling powder into water and mix well. Leave the liquid to thicken for 3 hours.



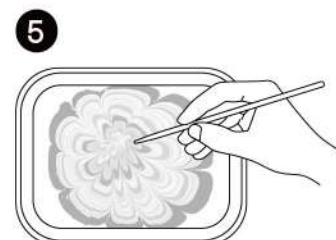
Once the liquid is a thick consistency, pour it into a tray or similar shaped container (not included). The liquid should be around 15cm deep.



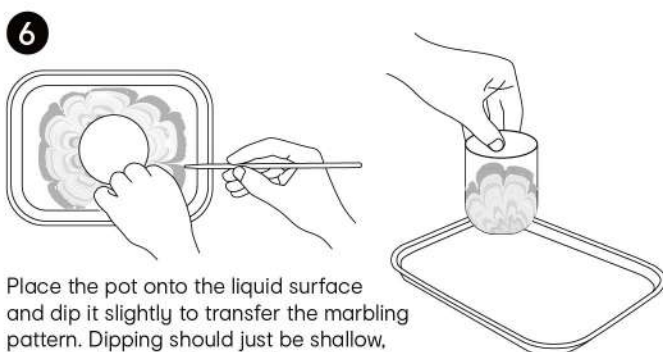
Gently squeeze the marbling paint 2cm above the liquid. Drop your first colour into the liquid.



Once the first paint colour has spread to your liking, drop more paint colours into the liquid.



Use the stick to swirl the floating colours and create your desired pattern.



Place the pot onto the liquid surface and dip it slightly to transfer the marbling pattern. Dipping should just be shallow, do not submerge the pot. Place the pot on a protected surface to dry.
