
How To Make A Macrame Coaster

Cut The Cords


- > 17cm x 8pcs
- > 58cm x 10pcs




Take a 17cm cord and tape it horizontally to a flat surface.




Take a 58cm cord and lay it vertically under the first cord.




Wrap the vertical cord around the horizontal cord and thread it through as shown to make a knot.




Tighten the 1st knot. Use tape fix the top of the vertical cord to the work space.




Make the 2nd knot as shown.




Tighten the 2nd knot.




Take the remaining 9pcs of 58cm cord and repeat steps 2-6, making knots along the horizontal cord. Once 10 cords are attached, the first row is complete.




Add another 17cm cord below to the 1st row and tape it to the work surface.




Repeat steps 3-6 and make 2 knots onto the 1st vertical cord.



Repeat steps 3–6, making knots along the second horizontal cord to complete the second row.



Add the remaining 6pcs of 17cm cord and repeat steps 8-10, completing 8 rows in total.



Trim the cord ends to around 2cm. To complete the coaster, brush the loose ends with a comb to create a fringed edge.
