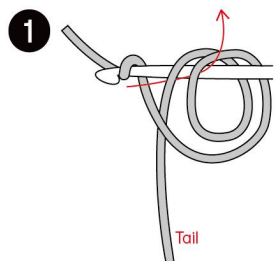


DIY Crochet Planter Cover

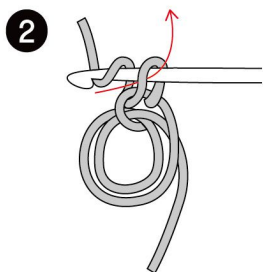
Kit Includes

- > 3 x tshirt yarns
- > 1 x crochet hook
- > 1 x instruction sheet

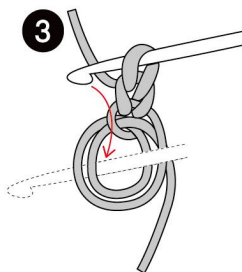
How To Make A Small Crochet Planter



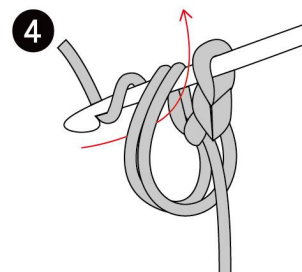
Make the base with a magic ring. Loop the yarn around the hook creating a ring with the tail hanging down as shown. Insert the hook through the ring and wrap the yarn around the hook end. Pull the hook back through the ring as shown.



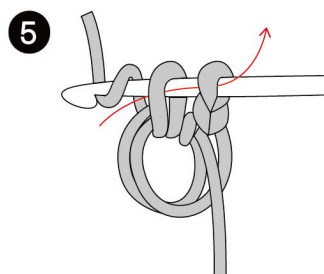
Wrap the yarn over the hook end again and pull it through the loop to make an upward chain.



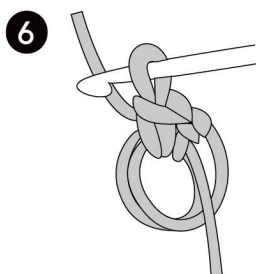
Now make crochets onto the ring. Insert the hook through the ring as shown.



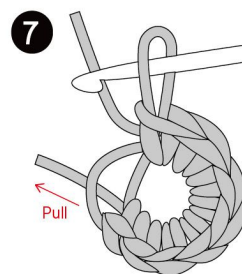
Wrap the yarn over the hook end and pull it through the ring.



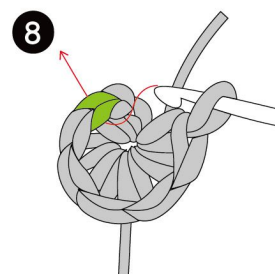
Wrap the yarn over the hook end again and pull it through both loops.



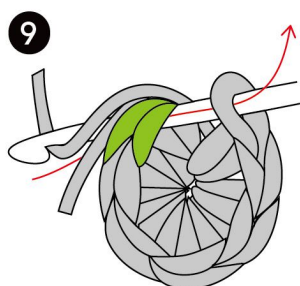
This completes your first single crochet onto the ring.



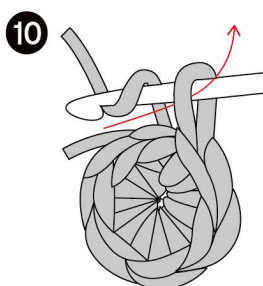
Repeat steps 3-6 and make 8 stitches for your first circle. Pull the yarn gently to tighten the circle.



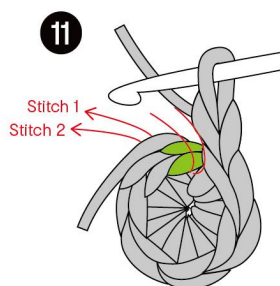
To connect the circle, insert the hook into your first crochet, behind 2 yarns as shown.



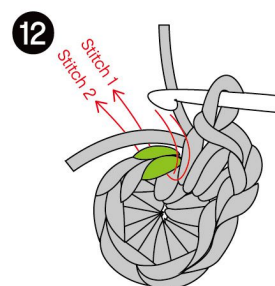
Wrap the yarn over the hook end and pull it back through the first stitch and the loop as shown. This completes the magic circle.



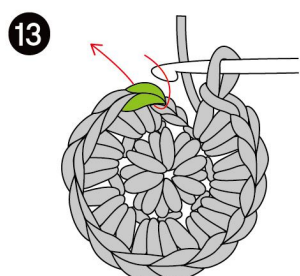
Wrap the yarn over the hook end and pull it through the loop to make an upward chain.



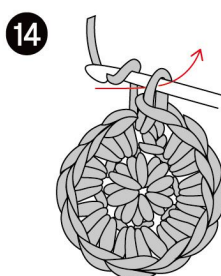
Then repeat steps 3-6. Stitch 2 crochets onto each stitch of the first circle by inserting the hook through the same hole both times.



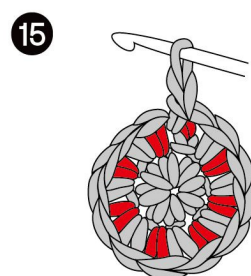
Continue 2 stitches in each until the end of the circle, completing 16 crochets on the 2nd circle.



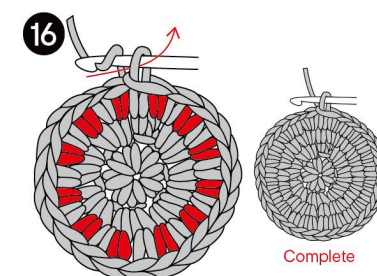
Repeat steps 8-9 to connect the ring and end the 2nd circle.



Wrap the yarn over the hook end and pull it through the loop to make an upward chain.



Stitch 1 crochet onto the 1st stitch of the 2nd circle, then stitch 2 crochets onto every 2nd stitch as shown in red. Continue around the ring, alternating between 1 and 2 stitches. Repeat steps 8-9 and end the 3rd circle with 24 stitches.

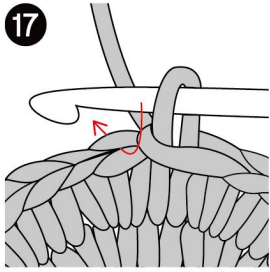


Repeat steps 14-15 to make the 4th circle with 36 stitches. The base of the planter is now complete.

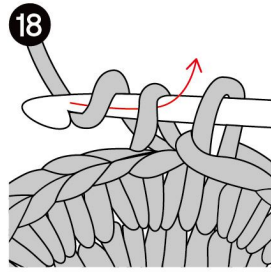
Tips:

- Make a magic ring to start your base.
- Find many great video tutorials online for stitches and methods.
- Create a loose weave by not pulling the stitches too tightly.
- Small planter: Make 4 circles for the base and 7 circles for the sides.
Large planter: Make 6 circles for the base and 10 circles for the sides.

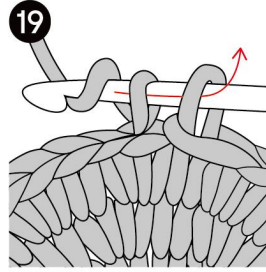
Add The Sides



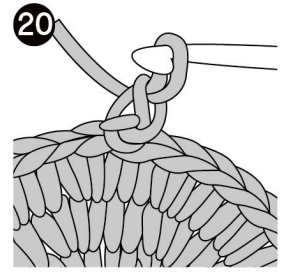
To begin rounding the basket, insert the hook through just 1 yarn of the first stitch on the last circle.



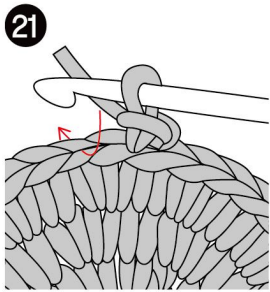
Wrap the yarn over the hook end and pull it through the first loop.



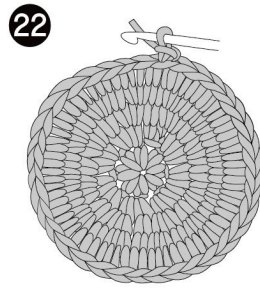
Then pull it through the second loop.



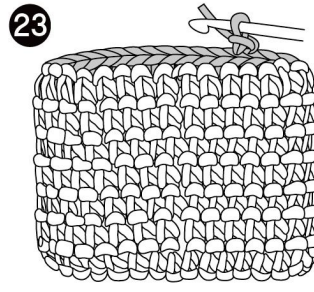
This completes your first single crochet of the 5th circle.



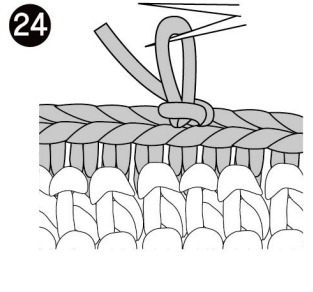
Repeat steps 17-20 around to complete the circle with 36 stitches.



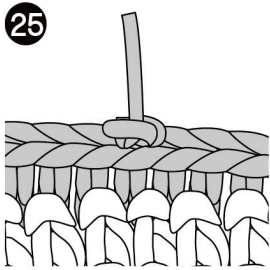
Repeat steps 2-6 to make the 6th-11th circles for the sides of the planter.



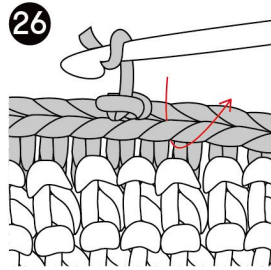
Repeat steps 8-9 to connect and end the 11th circle.



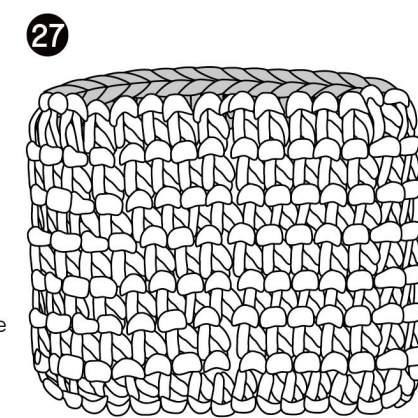
After ending the 11th circle, cut the excess yarn as shown.



Pull the excess yarn tightly and leave a 3cm tail.

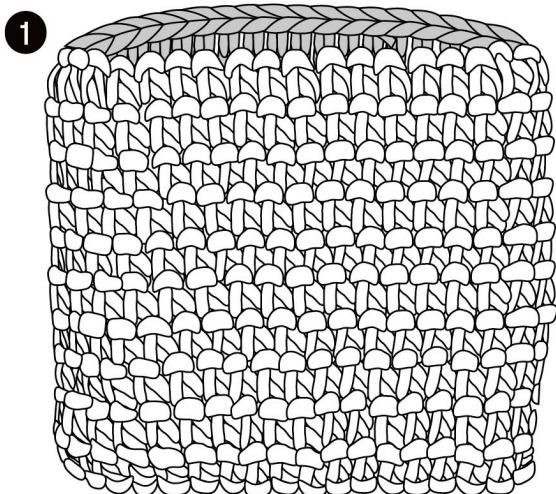


Wrap the yarn over the hook end and pull the tail through the stitches to hide it within the crochet.



Once your planter cover is complete, place a water tight pot plant inside to display a plant indoors.

How To Make A Large Crochet Planter



Repeat steps 1-27 using 6 circles for the base and 10 circles for the sides.
