4. Single Crochet (Abbreviated 'sc')
The single crochet is the most fundamental of all stitches.
Gather the year with your crochet hook and draw up the loop through the stitch. Wrop the year round the hook and pull it through two loops, leaving one loop on the hook.







5. Increase (Abbreviated 'inc')

You can increase stitches by adding a stitch of the row. Make 2 sc in the same knot.



6. Decrease (Abbreviated 'dec')

You can decrease atthose, which is radily just subtracting a stitch, in a row. Make a half so, at which point there are 2 loops in the hock, then crochet a half so in the neck not, at which point there are 3 loops in the hock, and finally wind the yern through all 3 loops to finish a dec.

7. Double Crochet (Abbreviated 'Do')
The double crochet is one of the most common crochet sitches and is about twice as tall as a single crochet. Wrap the year around the arochet hook. Then insert the crochet hook into the next sitch loop. Wrap the year with your erochet hook and pull the loop through the stitch (three loops now on the hook.) Wrap the year around the hook again and pull it through the first two loops leving two loops on the hook. Then, wrap the year around the hook again and pull through the first two loops leving a loop.


