8. Magic Ring A magic ring is an adjustable starting round used for crochet amigurumi patterns, granny squares and other patterns that work in archeter tounds. Form a loop with your year. You will need to loop the yorn around your lingers, insert the hook through the loop. Slide the crochet hook under right piece of yorn from right to left, use the hook tip to grab onto a left year, pull the yorn through the ring, make a chain stitch. Put your first row of stitches into the ring. For example, make 6 sc. Pull yarn ends. Hold the working end of the yorn tout while gently pulling down on the tail end. As you do this, the stitches should close together at the center, completing your magic ring. Finally, slip stitch into the first stitch. To close this round and start the remainder of your pattern, make a slip stitch into the first stitch of your ring, and proceed to the next round.

10. Fasten Off (Abbreviated 'F/O') Fasten off by pulling to pulling it taut. Cut off.






12. Sewing
Generally used for the connection of 2 parts. The plastic
needle strop yarns are threaded in turn through the knots
where the two parts need to be connected.

1. Body & Head (Places use the blue yarns) R1: 6 sc in maggic ring [6 sts] R3: (sc, inc) x 6 times [18 sts] R4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 times [24 sts]

R5. (3 sc, inc) x 6 times [30 sts]
R6: 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) x 5 times, 2 sc [36 sts]
R7: [5 sc, inc) x 6 times [42 sts]
Please alternate with different colours of yarns for R8-13. (Note: Steps marked in red ore white yarns).
R8. 15 sc, 4 sc (with the white yarns), 4 sc, 15 sc [42 sts]
R9. 14 sc, 6 sc, 2 sc, 6 sc, 14 sc [42 sts]
R10-E11 4 sc, 14 sc, 14 sc, 14 sc, 18 sc, 18 sc, 19 sc, 19 sc, 19 sc, 10 sc, 142 sts]
R13. 16 sc, 10 sc, 10 sc, 16 sc, 142 sts]

Make 4 sc in aligned knots at the opening to seal, F/O.

5. Sewing all the parts

1. Use the plastic needle to sew the belly onto the body then the feet and wings. (Fig. 1-2) Once finished, hide the excess threads inside the body.

2. Please use the block yorns to sew an "X" on both sides of RII of the body as the penguin's eyes and use the orange yarns to sew a horizontal 1" at the middle of RI2 as the penguin's mouth. (Fig. 3-4)
